8 Whereas, during the fall semester of 2011 the University of Montana (UM) became a tobacco-
9 free campus, not a nicotine-free campus;

10
11 Whereas, the Tobacco-Free Policy was implemented due to the following:

12
13 *“Support Quitters. Most tobacco users want to quit. The policy creates an environment*
14 *that supports their efforts. Increased cessation support for employees and students will*
15 *give the tools and the policy will create the supportive environment.*

16
17 *Reduce the number of new smokers. College has become an environment that*
18 *encourages smoking. Students report smoking more or even starting smoking in college.*
19 *The policy will create an environment that inhibits tobacco use rather than promotes it.”;*

21 Whereas, many students at UM use tobacco-free electronic cigarettes (e-cigs) in order to help quit
22 smoking cigarettes, and eventually quit nicotine use;

24 Whereas, the nicotine liquid contained in e-cigs is manufactured in the United States of America
25 (USA) and contains six major ingredients: distilled water, nicotine, vegetable glycerin, natural
26 flavors, artificial flavors, and citric acid;

27
28 Whereas, the University Center (UC) Board voted on Monday, November 18, 2013 to ban the use
29 of e-cigs, or other breathable vapor devices that create the appearance of smoking, in the UC;

30
31 Whereas, the UC Board, by a vote of four to one, banned e-cigs due to the fact that guests and
32 staff assumed that e-cigs and other tobacco-free products were included in the campus-wide
33 tobacco-free policy;

34
35 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, that ASUM does not support the UC Board’s decision to
36 ban all e-cig use in the UC;

37
38 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, that ASUM encourages the UC Board to repeal the current
39 ban on e-cigs;

40
41 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, that ASUM does not support any effort to ban e-cigs
42 across campus until further research has been done;

43
44 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be sent to Royce Engstrom,
45 President of UM; the UC Board; and UM’s Tobacco Taskforce.
