8       Whereas, pedestrian facilities on the Higgins Street Bridge are inadequate and unsafe;

9       Whereas, ASUM Transportation has found strong student and citizen support for improved  
10       pedestrian facilities on the Higgins Street Bridge;

11       Whereas, The Associated Students of The University of Montana recognizes the tentative plans  
12       for the improvement of the Higgins Street Bridge pedestrian facilities currently in the Missoula  
13       Downtown Master Plan;

14       Therefore, Let It Be Resolved that The Associated Students of The University of Montana  
15       endorses improved *encourages the City of Missoula to take up the issue of improving the*  
16       endorses improved pedestrian facilities on the Higgins Street Bridge.

17       ~~Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved that ASUM Transportation will submit a recommendation~~

23       ~~Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved that the appointed member of the ASUM Transportation~~  
24       ~~Board will give weekly reports to the ASUM Senate and may be given instructions by the Senate~~  
25       ~~or executives.~~

26       ~~Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved that the City Council observer will consult with the ASUM~~  
27       ~~Transportation Board for representation of this issue.~~
