10 Whereas, there are limited options of mass transportation available to residents of southern
11 Montana, ASUM ~~believes it is necessary~~ *driven* to support the development of such options;

12
13 Whereas, this service would connect 25 higher education institutions including Billings,
14 Bozeman, Butte, Helena, and Missoula on its route from Chicago to Seattle;

15
16 Whereas, this service would lower the student to vehicle ratio on campuses and decrease The
17 University of Montana's (UM) need to invest large capital into parking infrastructure;

18
19 Whereas, this service would expand the educational opportunities offered to Montana University
20 System (MUS) students by providing reliable transportation between the various MSU and UM
21 campuses around the state;

22
23 *Whereas, rail service, on average, is 19% more energy efficient than air travel and 28% more*
24 *energy efficient than auto travel;*

25
26 *Whereas, train service makes it easier for students to go "carless" saving them \$5,000 - \$8,000*
27 *annually;*

28
29 *Whereas, this service would create 269 permanent jobs plus many jobs making equipments and*
30 *rail improvements;*

32 Therefore, let it be resolved that the Associated Students of The University of Montana supports
33 the reopening of Amtrak's North Coast Hiawatha Route.

35 Let it be further resolved that the ASUM directs the Office of Transportation to continue its
36 lobbying efforts for the reopening of Amtrak's North Coast Hiawatha Routs

38 Let it be further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to President George Dennison,
39 Senator Max Baucus, Senator John Tester, and Representative Denny Rehberg.
