8 Let It Be Resolved that the language for the Athletic Fee Increase referendum read as follows:

10 “ The University of Montana Athletics facilities are in a state of needed repair. The University of
11 Montana is the lowest funded Athletic Program in the Big Sky Conference. The current Athletic
12 Facilities have been experiencing flooding, *and causing health issues, such as infections. and*
13 *health issues including staph infection and other infections.* Also this funding will be used to
14 build a new Art Annex for the students in the Art program. The new complex will have an
15 upgraded air quality control system and better facilities for Art students. The old complex will be
16 converted to expanded athletic facilities, which will provide a safe environment for all student
17 athletes. This increase in funding will not be used for scholarships, nor will it offset the current
18 budget. This will only be used to improve needed facilities. The increase would put the total fee
19 at \$72.10 for students taking 6 or more credits, and \$36.05 for students taking less than 6 credits.
