1 The Associated Students of The University of Montana 2 **Resolution Regarding Elections** 3 **December 4, 2013** 4 SB50-13/14 5 **Authored by: Samuel Thompson, ASUM Senator;** 6 7 Whereas, student groups play an active role on and off campus at The University of 8 Montana (UM); 9 10 Whereas, there are currently over 150 recognized student groups on campus; 11 12 Whereas, it is not specified in the ASUM bylaws that ASUM candidates cannot seek 13 endorsements during the elections process from ASUM-recognized student groups; 14 15 Whereas, during previous elections, when an ASUM candidate was endorsed by an 16 ASUM-recognized student group, the elections board either disqualified the candidate or 17 implemented another form of punishment; 18 19 Whereas, during ASUM Senate meetings, ASUM distributes funds to finance the 20 activities of ASUM-recognized student groups; 21 22 Whereas, a student group endorsement of an ASUM candidate could be seen as a 23 corrupting agent toward ASUM's budgeting process; 24 25 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Article V, Section 6, add subsection B and subsection 26 C which will state: 27 28 "B. Any candidate seeking an office within ASUM, who is knowingly endorsed 29 by an ASUM recognized student group shall be suspended from the elections 30 process. 31 32 C. Any candidate or candidate team seeking an office within ASUM, who claims 33 to be unknowingly endorsed by an ASUM-recognized student group shall be 34 brought before the Elections Committee, who will then recommend a course of 35 action, which the Senate may choose to overturn by a 2/3 majority vote." 36 37 38 Passed by Committee: December 2, 2013 39 40 Passed by ASUM Senate: December 4, 2013 41 42 43 44 Mariah Williams.
