8	Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) seeks to include all students
9	who wish to participate in student government;
10	
11	Whereas, Current Students at Large (SAL) may keep their seat on any committee after being appointed
12	senator regardless of whether another student wants to be on said committee;
13	
14	Whereas, This may prevent other students interested in serving as an SAL from receiving their desired
15	committee;
16	
17	Whereas, Having recently appointed senators keep their spots on committees as an SAL is sometimes
18	necessary for filling the committee;
19	
20	Whereas, Current ASUM Bylaws under Article III, Section 2, Subsection D read:
21	D. Any presidential appointments made to fill vacant Senate seats shall be approved by a two-
22	thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Senate. Any SAL appointed to the Senate shall have a choice to retain
23	their SAL status for all committees that they serve on.;

25	Therefore, Let It Be Resolved; That Article III, Section 2, Subsection D be amended to read as follows:
26	D. Any presidential appointments made to fill vacant Senate seats shall be approved by a two-thirds (2/3)
27	majority vote of the Senate
