Section 3 read: 19 1. President-Vice President team: The maximum expenditure allowed is \$200, with or 20 without a primary election. 2. Business Manager: The maximum expenditure allowed is \$150, with or without a 21 primary election. 22 23 3. Senators: The maximum expenditure allowed is \$75, with or without a primary 24 25 4. Candidates may choose to be reimbursed for campaigning expenditures to the amount 26 of \$10, dependent upon receipts following the General Elections. Expenditures exceeding \$10 will be matched 50% by ASUM. Total ASUM contributions shall not exceed \$37.50 27 for Senate candidates, \$75 for Business Manager candidates and \$100 for President/Vice 28 29 President candidates. All claimed expenditures for reimbursement must have receipts. Expenditures without receipts will not be matched by ASUM.; 30 31 32 Whereas, Current ASUM Fiscal Policy under section 25 read: 25.2 Candidates may choose to be reimbursed for campaigning expenditures to the 33 amount of \$10, dependent upon receipts following the General Elections. Expenditures 34 exceeding \$10 will be matched 50% by ASUM. Total ASUM contributions shall not 35 exceed \$37.50 for Senate candidates, \$50 for Business manager candidates and \$75 for 36 37 President/Vice President candidates. All claimed expenditures for reimbursement must 38 have receipts. Expenditures without receipts will not be matched by ASUM.: 39 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That Section 25.2 of ASUM Fiscal Policy be amended to read: 40 25.2 Candidates may choose to be reimbursed for campaigning expenditures to the 41 amount of \$10, dependent upon receipts following the General Elections. Expenditures 42 43 exceeding \$10 will be matched 50% by ASUM. Total ASUM contributions shall not exceed \$37.50 for Senate candidates, \$75 for Business manager candidates and \$100 for 44 President/Vice President candidates. All claimed expenditures for reimbursement must 45 have receipts. Expenditures without receipts will not be matched by ASUM. 46
