The Associated Students of the University of Montana 1 2 Resolution Regarding Board of Regents Policy Change (940.3 Section 4) April 8th, 2019 3 SB55-18/19 4 5 Authored by: Alex Butler, ASUM President; 6 7 Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) is recognized by the 8 Board of Regents as the student government for all students at the University of Montana per Board of Regents Policy 506.2; 9 10 Whereas, Current Board of Regents Policy 940.3 Section 4 reads: 11 "A. The budgets and funds in the possession of the associated student government 12 associations of the Montana University System, including student activity fees, shall be 13 allocated by only the officials of the respective student government. These allocation 14 15 processes will be pursuant to the Associated Students Constitution of the campuses, as approved by the campus's chief executive officer. No impairment of existing contractual 16 obligations shall occur in the allocation of such funds. 17 B. Students enrolled in the Law School are exempted from paying the regular student 18 activity fee, Such students shall, however, pay the Law School activity fee as provided 19 by Item 210-108, April 14, 2969."; 20 21 22 Whereas, Current students enrolled in the Alexander Blewett III School of Law pay a portion of the student activity fee, but currently receive the same services that a full fee-paying student 23 24 receives; 25 Whereas, ASUM believes that all students attending the University of Montana should pay the 26 same student activity fee, regardless of what college they are enrolled in; 27 28 Whereas, ASUM, pursuant to Board of Regents Policy 940.3 Section 4A, maintains oversight of 29 the student activity fee at the University of Montana; 30 31 32 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That ASUM recommends the following changes to Board of Regents Policy 940.3 Section 4: 33 "A. The budgets and funds in the possession of the associated student government 34 associations of the Montana University System, including student activity fees, shall be 35 36 allocated by only the officials of the respective student government. These allocation processes will be pursuant to the Associated Students Constitution of the campuses, as 37 approved by the campus's chief executive officer. No impairment of existing contractual 38 39 obligations shall occur in the allocation of such funds. B. Students enrolled in the Law School are exempted from paying the regular student 40 activity fee. Such students shall, however, pay the Law School activity fee as provided 41 42 by Item 210-108, April 14, 2969.": 43 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That ASUM recommends that all students enrolled at the 44 45 Alexander Blewett III School of Law pay the full student activity fee at the University of 46 Montana:
