**NCBI WORKSHOP ADDRESSES PREJUDICE**

**MISSOULA—**

The University of Montana will host a daylong prejudice reduction workshop from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday, Jan. 30, in the University Center.

The workshop, offered by the Missoula and UM campus affiliate chapters of the National Coalition Building Institute, is designed to create a safe learning environment for exploring misinformation about groups. Through small groups, discussion, facilitated storytelling and emotional support, participants will learn to undo stereotypes about race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, class, disabilities and other differences.
