





Problem-Solving	Appreciative Inquiry
Felt need, identification of problem(s)	Appreciating, valuing the best of what is
Analysis of causes	Envisioning what might be
Analysis of possible solutions	Engaging in dialogue about what should be
Action planning	Innovating, what will be
