## Bibliography of Aleyrodidae II

Family Aleyrodidae comprises of numerous species of whiteflies that are found all over the world damaging a vast majority of economic and ornamental crops. KHAN (1958) and SHARGA (1958) pointed out that the systematic studies on this group of insects have been very meagre and suggested the necessity of collecting the various species for proper identification and taking up work on their ecology, biology and control. Verily, a great majority of species all over the world, are yet to be unearthed and described. A need to collect and compile, the available literature was felt by TREHAN & BUTANI (1960) who published a comprehensive bibliography listing as many as 998 references and this is merely a supplement to that treatise.
