The checklist contains 622 species in 340 Genera and 107 Families.

Of the 622 species, 433 are native to the Lower 48 States; 181 are introduced; 6 are species that are native in some states and introduced in others; and 2 are species who's 'origin' is not known (because they have only been identified to genus, and both native and introduced representatives of that genus are present in Pennsylvania).'
