## DANISH DEEP-SEA EXPLORATION

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The new Danish Oceanographic Research Vessel, equipped to explore great depths, started on its first expedition at the end of April 1938. The route which she will follow passes through the North Sea and the Atlantic Ocean with some first stations near Iceland and the Färö Islands. The programme consists of hydrographic research, as a part of the International co-operation for the exploration of the Gulf Stream, and biological research particularly with a view to the study of the sea perch, a fish found in the region of the Färö Islands which has become of more and more recognised importance in recent years from an alimentary point of view. The expedition is in charge of Dr. Vedel TANING.
