INTRODUCTION

The Trinity Alps are a mountain range located about 50 miles northwest of Redding in Trinity and Siskiyou counties, California. They are a component of the Klamath Mountains, and as such lie between the Coast Range to the west and the Cascade Range to the east. Their flora is predominantly Sierran, a unique feature considering that the Trinity Alps are only about sixty miles from the Pacific coast. Elevations range from 1350 ft. along the Trinity River to 9002 ft. at Thompson Peak. The Alps are drained by the Salmon and Trinity Rivers. The area is shown on the Cecilville, Coffee Creek, and Trinity USGS maps. The Canyon Creek and Coffee Creek trails are the most popular access to the Alps.

The Trinity Alps Wilderness is a 517,000 acre region in the Klamath, Shasta-Trinity, and Six Rivers National Forests. It is the second largest wilderness area in California. The region is known for its spectacular views and rich flora, especially its diversity of conifer species.
