Assos, where Aristotle spent a few years before returning to Macedonia to teach the young Alexander, and birth place of Cleanthes, has been hosting an international conference on philosophy every year since 2000 under the auspices of the Association of Philosophy, Art and Science, based in Istanbul and presided by Örsan Öymen.
