Elton Marshall Eenigenburg graduated from Western Theological Seminary in 1940. He served as a RCA minister from 1940-1952; was professor of Christian Ethics and Philosophy of Religion at Western Theological Seminary, 1952-1985, and an academic dean, 1969-1977.
