### ***A Current Bibliography on the History of Canadian Population and Historical Demography in Canada, 1978***

This is a continuation of the bibliography undertaken last year.<sup>1</sup> It should be remembered that, to be listed here, a publication must fall into at least one of the categories used in the *International Bibliography of Historical Demography*.<sup>2</sup> Only books and articles which we had in hand could be enumerated.

A few publications which could not be seen in time to be included in the 1977 bibliography are mentioned here. Similarly, some titles published in 1978 which should appear in the present list may have been omitted. We may have overlooked a few others which our readers are kindly requested to bring to our attention, for inclusion in the next review.

Bibliographies published in *Acadiensis*, *B.C. Studies*, *Canadian Ethnic Studies*, *The Canadian Historical Review*, *Canadian Slavonic Papers*, and *Revue d'histoire de l'Amérique française* were helpful, as were *Anthropological Index* and *Population Index*. In addition, almost sixty periodicals, a list of which may be obtained from the author, were consulted.
