Correction: South African Renal Registry Annual Report 2015 - kidney transplants in KwaZulu-Natal

The numbers of new kidney transplants performed annually since 2012 in the public sector in the province of KwaZulu-Natal are given in the table below. These updated statistics replace the data available from the South African Organ Donor Foundation, which have been quoted in the annual reports of the South African Renal Registry [1,2]. In error, the numbers of transplants for 2013 and 2015 were recorded as zero, instead of "no data submitted". The records of the Organ Donor Foundation have also been updated accordingly.
