Offering you the last issue of "Clinical Diabetology" in 2018, I would like to draw your attention to an article referring to diabetes care for children and adolescents in Poland. The authors point to significant

Moreover, it is worth paying attention to the case report discussing iatrogenic hypoglycemia, which significantly widens the standard perception of this phenomenon, as well as an article about new developments in the pharmaceutical industry presenting new rapid-acting insulin analog.
