MAUDE E. CALLEN

Maude Callen has devoted her entire professional life as a nurse midwife to caring for the sick and needy in the backwoods of rural Berkeley County, South Carolina. For sixty years she has tried to be all things to her people: nurse, teacher, psychologist, dietician, friend and comforter.

Born eighty-five years ago in Quincy, Florida, Mrs. Callen was orphaned at age four and was raised by an aunt and uncle. In 1922 she was graduated from The Florida A&M College and received her nurse's training at the Georgia Infirmary at Savannah.

Mrs. Callen came to Berkeley County in 1923 as a United Thank Offering worker and missionary nurse for the Protestant Episcopal Church. She found there a tremendous need for health care among the people in the remote areas of the county, and it made a great impression on this young nurse just beginning a life of service.

Settling in the Pineville community, she traveled by wagon and cart over nearly impassable dirt roads to treat the sick and needy. Two rooms in her small home served as a clinic. She was 22 miles from the county hospital and 10 miles from the nearest doctor.

When people became ill, they usually went for "Miss Maude," who always was available day and night, seven days a week. Her workday often was as long as 16 hours. Making a house call on a cold winter's night to deliver a baby, Mrs. Callen would build a fire in a pot in the wagon for warmth. She has been to homes which were impossible to reach even by wagon and had to cross ditches and creeks by foot, by walking on logs.

In 1936 she was employed by the Berkeley County Health Department as a public health nurse. She ran the first prenatal clinic and venereal disease clinic in the county with the assistance of a private physician.

National attention was brought to her good works in 1951 when **Life Magazine** featured this remarkable individual in an article entitled "Nurse Midwife; Maude Callen Eases Pain of Birth, Life and Death." In photograph after photograph, Mrs. Callen was shown on her daily rounds going into homes, delivering babies, and caring for the aged, the sick, and the blind.

In 1969 in a book of his "Photographs and Notes," the author of the article, Eugene Smith, had been so moved by what he had seen that he wrote the following comments about what it had meant to him personally to have met "Miss Maude."

"This essay on the nurse midwife, Maude Callen, is in many ways, the most rewarding experience photography has allowed me. In the most special way, she is probably the greatest person I have ever been privileged to know; combining marvelous wisdom and compassion, a strength of true humility and true pride, all given direction through knowledge and purpose in a sheerly beautiful balance."

When the nation read about Mrs. Callen, donations poured in from many people who wanted to stand up and cheer for her and to express their support for her mission. She used the \$27,000 in gifts to fulfill a longtime dream. She built a modern clinic in her home area of the Pineville community.

If ever someone has lived a life which exemplifies the true meaning of the word "humanitarian," it is "Miss Maude." Her remarkable life of service to others is an outstanding example for all of us to reflect on in this modern world where purpose and meaning are sometimes difficult to define in the rush of daily living.

Clemson University holds her and her accomplishments in the highest regard, and it is a special privilege for all of us at Clemson to honor her in this way.
