Fort Hill

On settlement this day between J. C. Calhoun & A. P. Calhoun on one side & Thos. G. Clemson on the other there is found due by the two former (A. P. & J. C. Calhoun) to the latter on all transactions connected with the settlement of the late Drake place Marengo Alabama the sum of twenty four thousand one hundred & fourteen dollars as appears by the above statement to which this is annexed. This amount has been liquidated by a due bill for \$7,114 payable on demand & two promissory notes payable to order of Thos. G. Clemson each for \$8,500 due in March of 1845 & March of 1846. The settlement includes the purchase money still due of six thousand dollars for certain negroes purchased of Mrs. Joor & for which the said J. C. & A. P. Calhoun & T. G. Clemson gave their joint bonds to J. R. Matthews the trustee of Mrs. Joor. In this settlement the said J. C. & A. P. Calhoun have assumed to pay the two thousand dollars being the one third part with the interest now due.
