This Indenture was made and concluded the twenty fifth day of June Eighteen hundred and thirty three

between David C. Gibson of said County of the one part and John C. Calhoun of the other witnesseth that the said David C. Gibson for and in consideration of the sum of six thousand dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, hath bargained sold conveyed and doth by these presents bargain sell and convey unto the said John C. Calhoun his heirs and assigns all that tract or lot of land situate in said County known as the O'Barre tract more adjoining Matthew Blackwell and others containing two hundred and thirty nine (239) acres more or less having such form as will appear from the States plat of the same, which said bargained premises together with all the appurtenances, the said David C. Gibson from his heirs and assigns, doth forever warrant and defend the right and title thereof to the said John C. Calhoun his heirs and assigns against the claims of any and all persons whatsoever.
