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


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

TRENDS IN THE POPULATION OF TENNESSEE NONMETROPOLITAN AND METROPOLITAN COUNTIES, 1960-1980

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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to investigate selected characteristics of nonmetropolitan and metropolitan population in Tennessee. Data were obtained from the 1960, 1970 and 1980 Censuses of Population and the following characteristics are presented:

Data are aggregated by county totals and nonmetropolitan and metropolitan totals for the state. These data were obtained from: Center for Data Systems and Analysis, Montana State University, Bozeman, Montana 59717. Explanatory notes and definitions associated with the data are presented in the Appendix of this report.

The Standard Metropolitan Statistical Area (SMSA) concept was initiated by the Bureau of the Census in 1950 (originally called Standard Metropolitan Area). SMSA boundaries correspond with county boundaries; more than one county may be included in a given SMSA; and an SMSA may include counties in more than one state. The basic criterion for an SMSA is that there be a central city or cities with 50,000 or more inhabitants in the incorporated limits (or the concentrated area adjacent to the incorporated limits of a central city or cities). The criteria for including other counties center around the magnitude of non-agricultural labor force commuting to work to an SMSA central city, or the county in

which the city is located. The density of population and concentration of economic activities are also factors (U.S. Bureau of the Census, 1982). In this report, 1980 metropolitan designations are held constant; that is, 1980 metropolitan counties are considered metropolitan counties in 1970 and 1960.

Tennessee has 72 nonmetropolitan counties and 23 metropolitan. The distribution of these counties is shown in Map 1. The aggregated population and selected characteristics for the two respective designations are presented in Table A. According to the 1980 Census of Population, nonmetropolitan inhabitants (1,706,911) were fewer in number than metropolitan inhabitants (2,884,209) by 1,177,298. Expressed as percentages, in 1980 37.2 percent of the people in Tennessee lived in nonmetropolitan areas and 62.8 percent in metropolitan areas. There was a slight tendency during the period 1960 to 1980 toward metropolitanization of the population as the increase in metropolitan counties of 668,583 inhabitants was proportionately greater than the 355,448 increase for nonmetropolitan counties.

In Tennessee the Black population is concentrated in the metropolitan counties. In fact, in 1980 nearly half of the Black population (44.7 percent) resided in one county, Shelby (Memphis). Add the next three most populous counties (Davidson, Knox, and Hamilton) and the residences of 71 percent of the state's Blacks are included. Since 1960, the proportion of the population that is Black has decreased slightly from 16.5 percent to 15.8 percent in 1980. The nonmetropolitan counties have experienced a decrease in the total numbers of Blacks over the two decades while white

population numbers have increased. The percentage of Blacks in nonmetropolitan counties has decreased from 11.2 in 1960 to 8.4 in 1980. In the metropolitan counties there has been a very slight percentage increase during this same period, from 19.7 to 20.2.

The median age has increased in both the metropolitan and nonmetropolitan populations of the state with the greater increase occurring in the more rural areas. In 1960 the 28.66 median age for the nonmetropolitan population was almost one year higher than for the metropolitan population. This difference increased to one and two-thirds years in 1980 when the nonmetropolitan median age reached 31.32 years. The differences in the medians do not reflect the dramatic changes that took place in the age structure of these two populations. Both had decreases in the proportion under 15 of age and both had increases in the proportion aged 15 through 29 with this increase being greater in the metropolitan counties. Both metropolitan and nonmetropolitan populations had substantial increases in the proportion over 55, just under four percent for the two decades. The national trends of reduced birthrates and increasing longevity are reflected in these figures.

The two groups of counties have had very different experiences over the past twenty years with respect to population migration. In the first ten years the nonmetropolitan counties experienced a net outmigration of about 3.5 percent while the metropolitan counties had an almost negligible inmigration. For the second decade, both experienced inmigration. This amounted to only 1.6 percent for the metropolitan counties while for the

nonmetropolitan it was much higher at 14.2 percent. The proximity of this growth to the metropolitan areas reflects a real interest in small town and open-country living while having access to urban services, again, part of a national trend.

NONMETROPOLITAN COUNTIES

Population and selected characteristics for the 72 non-metropolitan counties of Tennessee are presented in Tables
TN-NONMET-1 through TN-NONMET-72, Bedford through White Counties.
Data for two counties are presented on each page. The largest nonmetropolitan county in 1980 was Madison with the city of
Jackson and a population of 74,546 in 1980. The smallest was
Pickett with 4,358 residents in 1980, closely followed by Moore
with 4,510. The nonmetropolitan county with the largest Black
population in 1980 was Fayette (12,804) with Haywood (10,420)
running a strong second. Putnam County was the only nonmetropolitan county in 1980 with more than 500 people classified as
"Other" with respect to race, while Bradley had just under that
figure.

The nonmetropolitan county with the oldest median age in 1980 was Stewart with a median age of 35.1 years. This distinction was achieved by a combination of natural aging of the population and inmigration of older people. Fayette County had the lowest median age at 27.3 years. This characteristic is associated with a history of heavy outmigration and a relatively high birth rate.

Forty-nine of the 72 nonmetropolitan counties had net outmigration in the 1960's and then net inmigration during the 1970's. Four counties had outmigration in both decades: Hancock,

Hardeman, Haywood, and Lake. Only Lake had a population decline between 1970 and 1980. The others experienced a natural increase that exceeded net outmigration. Lake and twenty other counties had population losses in the 1960's decade but all except Lake reversed the process in the 1970's with some having very substantial gains.

The nonmetropolitan county that experienced the greatest 1970-1980 percentage increase in population was Sevier with 46.7 percent. The population increased by 13,177 people, with most of the increase attributable to net inmigration, which amounted to 39.4 percent.

METROPOLITAN COUNTIES

Population and selected characteristics for the 23 Tennessee metropolitan counties are presented in Tables TN-METRO-1 through TN-METRO-23, Anderson through Wilson Counties. According to the 1980 Census of population, the largest of the metropolitan counties in Tennessee is Shelby, which includes the city of Memphis, with 777,113 residents. It is, of course, the largest of all the counties in terms of numbers of residents. The smallest metropolitan county which also includes an SMSA central city is Sullivan (Bristol SMSA) with 143,968 residents. The smallest county included in an SMSA is Union with 11,707 inhabitants.

As mentioned above, nearly half of the state's Black population is in one metropolitan county, Shelby (44.7 percent). Those classified as being of "Other" races make up less than one percent of the metropolitan population. Montgomery County had the

largest proportion in the "Other" category at 2.7 percent while Shelby had the largest number so classified, just under 7,000.

The metropolitan county with the oldest median age in 1980 was Unicoi with a median age of 33.7, which is about four years higher than the average for the metropolitan counties. Unicoi's increase in the median age of 5.7 years during the two decades with a limited change in total population suggests that there was either selective in and out migration or a very low death rate. The county with the youngest median age in 1980 was Montgomery with 25.8 years, about four years lower than the average for the metropolitan counties. The young age reflects the proximity of a major military base.

All of the metropolitan counties except Shelby experienced net inmigration during the decade of the 1970's. Shelby had a small net outmigration in both decades. The metropolitan county with the highest rate of net inmigration was Williamson with 60.9 percent. Williamson also had the highest percentage gain in population between 1970 and 1980 with 68.8 percent. The largest numerical gain occurred in Shelby County with 55,002. Knox County was second with 43,401. Shelby County's increase in the one decade was greater than the total population of 79 of the state's counties in 1980.

IMPLICATIONS


Since 1960 the number of residents has increased in 91 of Tennessee's 95 counties. Most of these counties can expect a continuing increase in population for the present. With an increase in population there is always an increase in the demand

for services, both public and private. Basic services involving transportation, treated water, electricity, waste disposal and communication lines will need to be expanded if even the same quality of living is to be maintained. Demands for improving the quality of living also need to be anticipated.

The composition of the increasing population also needs to be considered in anticipating the kinds of services for which the demands will increase. There has been an increase in the proportion in the 15 through 29 age cohort. Provision for employment in a stable work environment is important if social stability is to be promoted and outmigration minimized. The increasing numbers and proportion of the population in the over 65 age group is also influential in the nature of the services demanded. Given that most of these citizens are reasonably secure financially, they can be very assertive in letting their interest in various services be known. They do have some special health needs as well as need for transportation services as they get older. Both of these needs must be met if the quality of their lives is not to deteriorate seriously.

There appears to be little prospect for a dramatic shift in proportions living in metropolitan and nonmetropolitan areas for the state as a whole. At the same time there are likely to be local situations that will result in a drastic change in the composition of the population in a given area. When that happens, there is a degree of tension between the incumbents and the inmigrants that can last beyond the current generation of the county. Efforts to accommodate the interests of both groups at

the outset can have long term benefits if there is full and open communications of the basis for, and the expected impact of, such accommodation.

APPENDIX

Explanatory Notes to Accompany Data from the Center for Data Systems and Analysis, Montana State University

I. The 1980 data were obtained from U.S. Bureau of the Census computer tape files obtained in August, 1982. Data in the files are termed "final counts" but minor "corrections" were subsequently expedited by the Bureau. Consequently, some data presented here may vary slightly from other 1980 sources.

Data for 1960 and 1970 came primarily from the Bowles (Bowles and Beale, 1975) net migration data set, which matches census data in the 1967 and 1972 County-City Data Books (U.S. Bureau of the Census, 1967, 1973). To get race data for blacks, percentages from these data books were applied to the Bowles population figures. The "Other" race category was generated by subtracting white and black totals from the population total. Use of this method produced zero "Other" race inhabitants for several counties in 1960.

In 1980 the U.S. Bureau of the Census modified the procedures for collecting data on race of the population. This modification, in effect, encouraged respondents to classify themselves in an "Other" race category if they wished. This modification accounts for much of the increase in "Other" race population between 1970 and 1980.

- II. The 1970-77 net migration figure is from Department of Commerce Current Population Survey Reports Population

 Estimates (U.S. Bureau of the Census, 1979). This value represents a 7.75 year average of net migration. The 1970-80 net migration value was computed by using the population estimates for 1970-77 and augmenting them with state birth and death data for 1978 and 1979 as indicated in the following notes.
 - A. Data Used for Estimation of 1970-1980 Net Migration:
 - 1. Census population totals for counties, 1970, 1980
 - 2. Births and deaths for counties of residence April 1, 1970 to December 31, 1977.
 - 3. Births and deaths for counties of residence 1978 and 1979.

B. Method:

- 1. Estimation of county births from 1970 to 1980:
 - a. for each state, 1970-77 births in all counties were summed to produce a value for 1970-77 births: SBIRTH7077 = CBIRTH7077
 - b. for each county a 1970-77 proportion of state births was calculated:

- c. This portion was applied to the sum of state births in 1978 and 1979: CBIRTH7879 -CPBIRTH7077 x (SBIRTH78 = SBIRTH79)
- d. this portion was added to county births for 1970-77 to obtain a county figure for births from April, 1970, to December, 1979: CBIRTH7079 -CBIRTH7077 + CBIRTH7879

- e. this value was corrected to represent 40 quarters rather than 39, by dividing by 39/40 or .975:
 CBIRTH7080 = CBIRTH7079/.975
- 2. CDEATH7080 was estimated using an analogous procedure and data for deaths instead of for births.
- 3. Natural increase for 1970-80 was calculated by subtracting the death estimate from the birth estimate: NINC7080 = CBIRTH7080 CDEATH7080
- 4. Net migration for 1970-80 was calculated by subtracting estimated natural increase from population change from 1970 to 1980: NMIG7080E = POPULATION80 POPULATION70 NINC7080E
- C. "Net Migration Rate." Migration rates are net migration estimates expressed as percentages of the Time 2 expected survivors of the Time 1 population and births during the decade.

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
