## 2012 Multidisciplinary Research Award

### Living Light Team

This year, the award goes to the Living Light team led by **EDGAR STACH**, **BARBARA KLINKHAMMER**, and **JAMES ROSE** of the College of Architecture and Design; **LEON TOLBERT** and **BILL MILLER** of the College of Engineering; and **DEBORAH SHMERLER** of the College of Arts and Sciences. This team combined resources and knowledge to create an energy-efficient, solar-powered home as part of the US Department of Energy's Solar Decathlon. More than 200 students in nine academic programs were involved, and forty students and faculty went to Washington, DC, to assemble and exhibit the house to compete in the international competition. More than 18,000 people toured the house and the team placed eighth overall.



The **Success in Multidisciplinary Research Award** goes to a team of faculty members who have succeeded in gaining external resources and recognition for their research.
