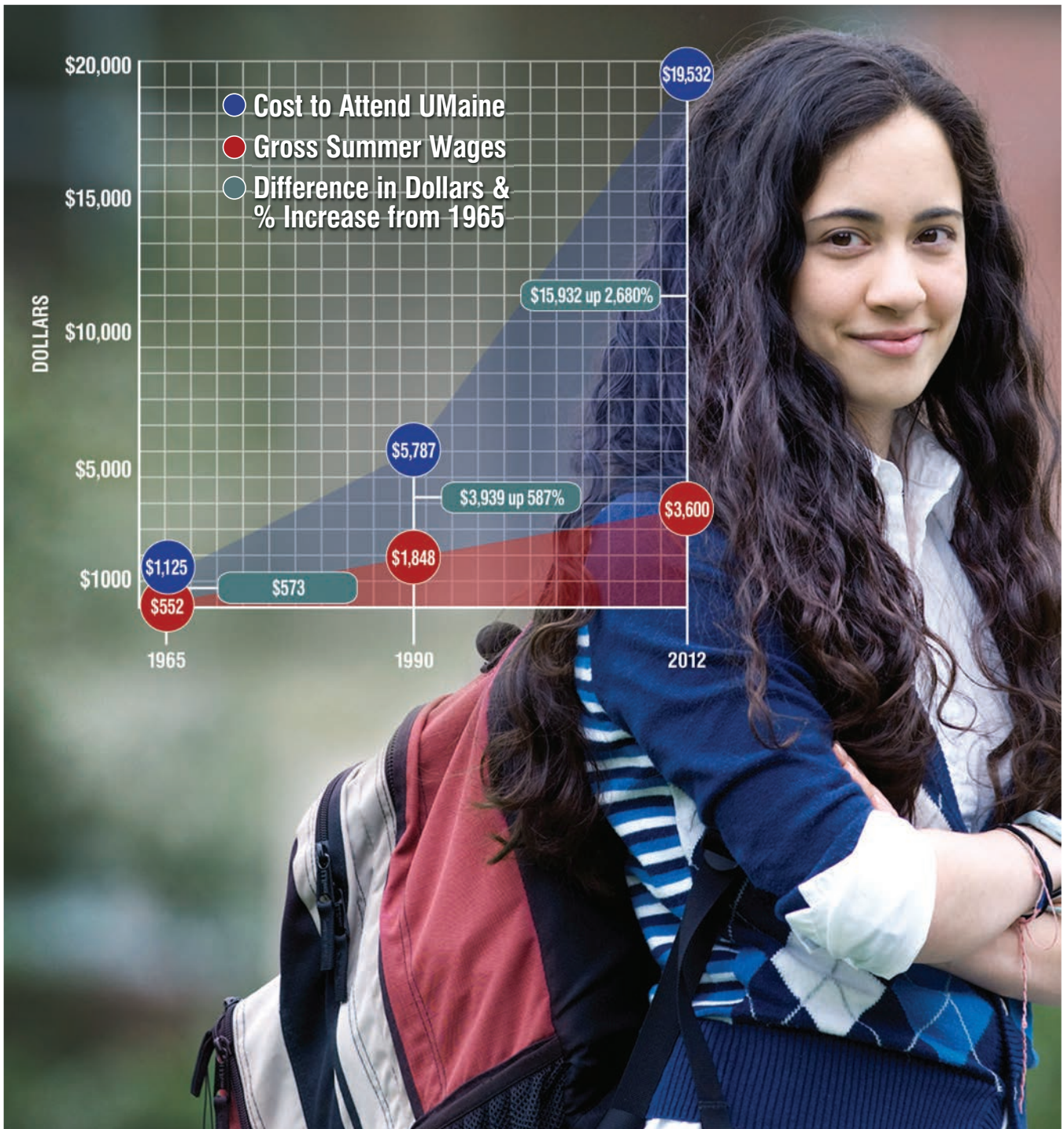

This chart compares the cost of tuition/fees, room and board between 1965 and 2012.

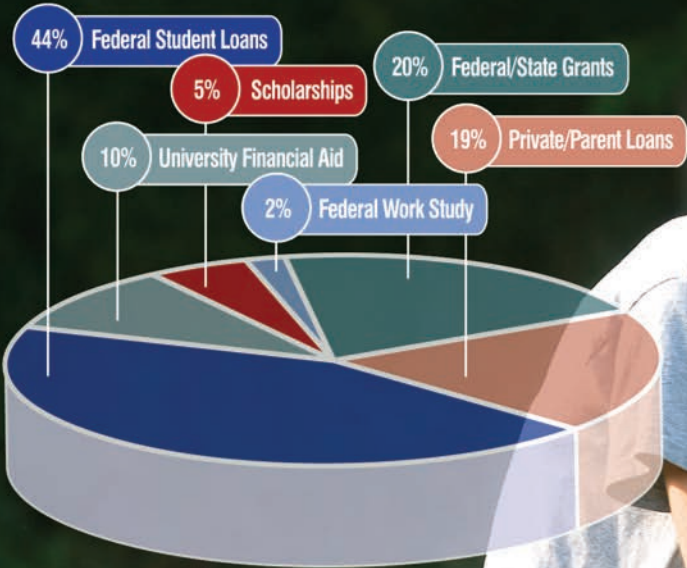


Student wages have not kept up with the cost of education.

In 1965, a student could work 12 weeks in the summer at minimum wage and be able to pay 49% of their education costs.

In 2011, today's entering first-year students can cover only 18% of their educational costs through summer wages.

Letter from the
P R E S I D E N T
& B O A R D C H A I R

The theme for this year's annual report is overcoming challenges. Our focus is directly on students and the obstacles to education that the entering class of 2015 faces. With our country on a slow road to economic recovery, students are increasingly strained to fund their education, making private support more important than ever.

In 1965—the 100th anniversary of the University of Maine—tuition, fees, room, board and books for a first-year student residing in Maine was \$1,325. Estimated expenses for the incoming Class of 2015, whose graduation will coincide with the University's 150th anniversary, are \$20,532. Even adjusted for inflation, costs are rapidly increasing. Unlike many of us who were able to fill the gap in paying for our education by working our way through college, today's students find themselves working just as hard, yet unable to meet their funding needs. As a result, the average student is graduating from UMaine with a debt load of nearly \$23,000.

The quality of a university depends on a consistent source of revenue, year after year. That is precisely the value of a strong endowment. The good news is that Foundation endowments are rebounding. Our endowment return for FY11 was 20.18%. At the end of FY10, total assets were \$162 million. As of June 30, 2011, total assets are \$184,275,000. During fiscal year 2011, gifts processed were 2,080 totaling \$6,649,135. The Foundation holds 1,349 endowed funds. This is an increase of 44 over FY10. The University of Maine Foundation is honored to be a steward for endowed gifts that shape the future of the University and its students.

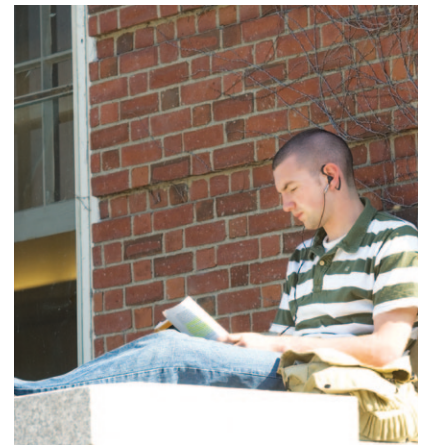

Planned gifts change the lives of the donors who make them and the students who benefit from them. Your support will enable students of every background and ambition at the University of Maine, from first-generation college enrollees to dedicated graduate researchers, to reach their goals while continuing to make the University of Maine a leader in higher education.

A variety of assets can be used to establish a planned gift. From cash to real estate to tangible personal property, the Foundation staff is ready to assist you and your advisors to find the best fit for your personal circumstances.

Perhaps the most common form of a planned gift is through a bequest. If you wish to leave the University of Maine Foundation a bequest in your will or trust for a scholarship or some other purpose, you can amend your will or trust to reflect your wishes.

The following represents sample language for doing so.

"I give and bequeath to the University of Maine Foundation for the benefit of the University of Maine (possible choices below):

- *_____ percent of my estate; or*
- *the property described herein to establish (or benefit if already existing) the _____ Fund. The principal of said Fund is to be endowed and only the income earned on the principal shall be used to provide financial assistance."*

For those individuals that have additional charitable interests outside the University of Maine, the Foundation will help you establish a donor-advised fund. This is a cost-effective alternative to a private family foundation and allows you to consolidate and manage all of your charitable giving.

S P E N D I N G
Policy

Every Foundation has a unique mission, culture and circumstance. Therefore, many elements contribute to our spending policy decision, especially our investment policy, asset allocation and inflation. Decisions about spending policies can have long lasting ramifications. It is important that our assets' growth be available for the future generations of our intended beneficiaries.

The Foundation's objective in managing its endowed funds is to generate an income stream for distribution to the University and provide for adequate growth in the endowments. To facilitate the achievement of these goals, the Foundation operates the General Endowment Fund on a total return basis, which focuses on the overall return of the investment portfolio including both investment income (interest and dividends) and capital appreciation (realized and unrealized). Under the total return method, an endowment spending rate of the invested assets is established versus only spending from interest and dividend income.

The Foundation's spending rate, as established by its Board of Directors, is 5.25% of the five-year average fair-market value of the investment pool. To provide for the accumulation of earnings, only endowment funds that have been in the General Endowment at least one year will be eligible for spending.

D I R E C T O R S
Reserve Fund

As a result of the 2008 economic downturn and the effect it has had on our endowed funds, in February 2011 the Board voted to create a Directors Reserve Fund. Should the need arise, funds from this account will be used by the Board of Directors to fulfill operational, maintenance and capital needs including the funding of underwater endowments.

The goal is to have a reserve of \$4 million by July 1, 2021. This will be achieved by setting aside a reserve amount each year for 10 years at the rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ of 1% of the value of the endowment, as long as the Foundation's General Endowment Investment reaches 12%, net of fees. The monies will be invested in the Foundation's cash management account or other similar low-risk investment vehicle.

Having a reserve account will provide fiscal stability for the Foundation and help it meet pressing and unforeseen needs of the University during times of diminishing resources.

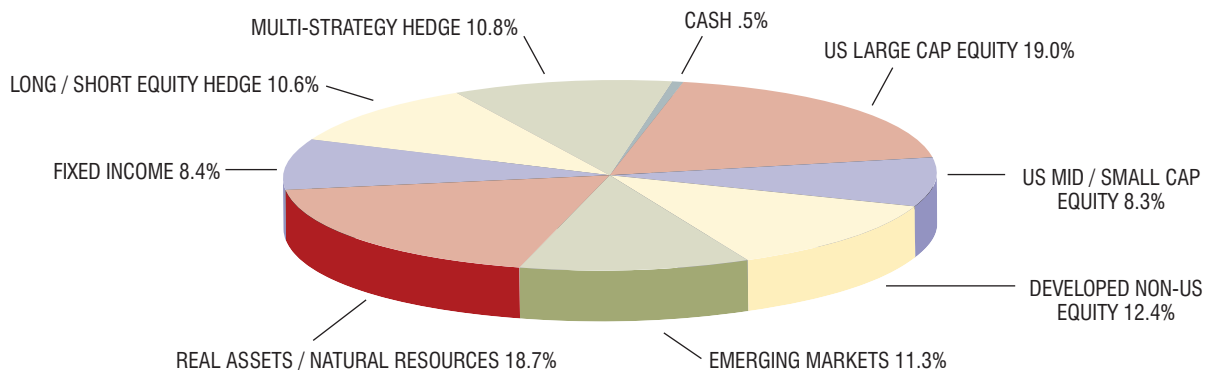

ALLOCATION

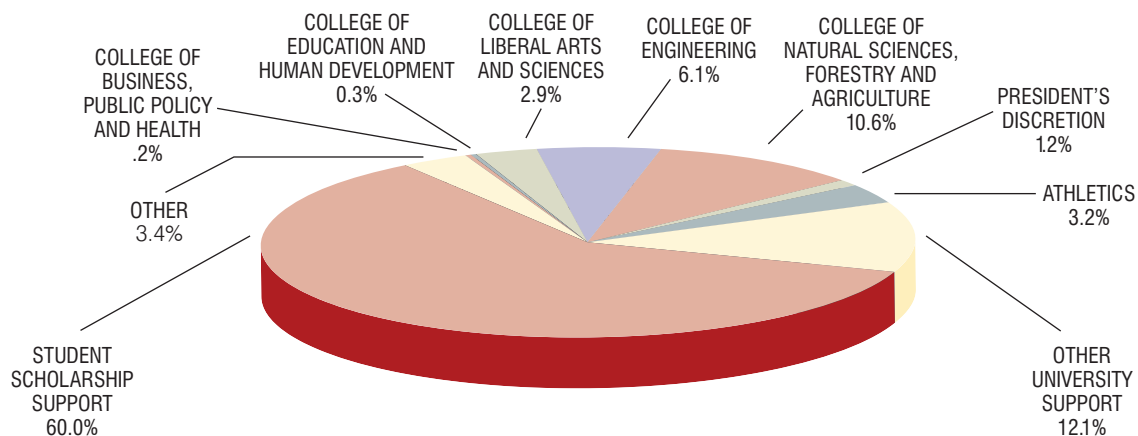

Alaric Faulkner Scholarship

Alaric Faulkner, UMaine Professor Emeritus of Anthropology, passed away in 2011. This fund was established with gifts in his memory. The fund will support deserving undergraduate anthropology majors in their third year of study.

Stanley L. Freeman and Patricia Smith Ranzoni Aspirations Scholarship

Patricia Smith Ranzoni initiated this fund in honor of her advisor, Stanley L. Freeman. The details of the fund description have not yet been finalized.

Catherine F. George Scholarship

Catherine George '47 created this scholarship through her will for students who are graduates of a secondary school in Barnstable County, Massachusetts who are studying in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

Ruth W. Gilchrist '51 Fund

Ruth Gilchrist Addison '51 created this fund with the remaining assets of a pooled life income fund. The fund will be used at the discretion of the Foundation Board of Directors.

Joline Godfrey Scholarship

Joline Godfrey '72 established this fund for student scholarships. The details of the fund description have not yet been finalized.

Linwood E. Lufkin '58 and Mabel S. Lufkin Scholarship

Linwood E. Lufkin '58 and Mabel S. Lufkin established this scholarship for undergraduate students majoring in engineering and engineering technology. The scholarship may be renewed based on the student's academic performance.

Maine Smart Grid Center Excellence Fund

This fund was created through a grant from the Robert Haskell and Gladys Stetson Fund of the Maine Community Foundation. The fund shall support student wages, equipment, supplies, and other activities related to intelligent systems and the Center in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering.

Valerie J. Mitchell Nontraditional Student Scholarship

Alvin 'Al' McNeilly '44 established this fund in appreciation and honor of Valerie Mitchell's many years of work at the University of Maine Alumni Association. She is a nontraditional student from the Class of 2008 and chose to have this fund assist deserving nontraditional students selected by the Senior Alumni Scholarship Committee.

Dr. Arnold R. Moody '63 and Donna Rich Moody Scholarship

Dr. Arnold Moody '63 and Donna Rich Moody established this fund with the goal of creating opportunities for others for a life filled with receiving and giving. Recipients shall be students in the College of Natural Sciences, Forestry & Agriculture.
