







The pie chart shows the breakdown of how UMaine students cover their educational costs.


Note: Only 5% of student aid is covered by scholarships.



The theme for this year's annual report is overcoming challenges. Our focus is directly on students and the obstacles to education that the entering class of 2015 faces. With our country on a slow road to economic recovery, students are increasingly strained to fund their education, making private support more important than ever.

In 1965—the 100th anniversary of the University of Maine—tuition, fees, room, board and books for a first-year student residing in Maine was \$1,325. Estimated expenses for the incoming Class of 2015, whose graduation will coincide with the University's 150th anniversary, are \$20,532. Even adjusted for inflation, costs are rapidly increasing. Unlike many of us who were able to fill the gap in paying for our education by working our way through college, today's students find themselves working just as hard, yet unable to meet their funding needs. As a result, the average student is graduating from UMaine with a debt load of nearly \$23,000.

The quality of a university depends on a consistent source of revenue, year after year. That is precisely the value of a strong endowment. The good news is that Foundation endowments are rebounding. Our endowment return for FY11 was 20.18%. At the end of FY10, total assets were \$162 million. As of June 30, 2011, total assets are \$184,275,000. During fiscal year 2011, gifts

processed were 2,080 totaling \$6,649,135. The Foundation holds 1,349 endowed funds. This is an increase of 44 over FY10. The University of Maine Foundation is honored to be a steward for endowed gifts that shape the future of the University and its students.

Private support from you, our committed donors, is deeply appreciated and much needed. Scholarships can help make the student's burden lighter, and open more doors for their futures. If just one-half of the more than 95,000 alumni each left a legacy of \$20,000, which is the amount needed to fully establish a named scholarship, we would have an endowment of \$950,000,000. It's an admirable goal and one that can be reached with your help.

To continue bringing success and opportunities to our students, we need your ongoing support. Students are the promise of tomorrow.

SPEND-ING Policy

Every Foundation has a unique mission, culture and circumstance. Therefore, many elements contribute to our spending policy decision, especially our investment policy, asset allocation and inflation. Decisions about spending policies can have long lasting ramifications. It is important that our assets' growth be available for the future generations of our intended beneficiaries.

The Foundation's objective in managing its endowed funds is to generate an income stream for distribution to the University and provide for adequate growth in the endowments. To facilitate the

achievement of these goals, the Foundation operates the General Endowment Fund on a total return basis, which focuses on the overall return of the investment portfolio including both investment income (interest and dividends) and capital appreciation (realized and unrealized). Under the total return method, an endowment spending rate of the invested assets is established versus only spending from interest and dividend income.

The Foundation's spending rate, as established by its Board of Directors, is 5.25% of the five-year average fair-market value of the investment pool. To provide for the accumulation of earnings, only endowment funds that have been in the General Endowment at least one year will be eligible for spending.

DERECTORS Reserve Fund

As a result of the 2008 economic downturn and the effect it has had on our endowed funds, in February 2011 the Board voted to create a Directors Reserve Fund. Should the need arise, funds from this account will be used by the Board of Directors to fulfill operational, maintenance and capital needs including the funding of underwater endowments.

The goal is to have a reserve of \$4 million by July 1, 2021. This will be achieved by setting aside a reserve amount each year for

10 years at the rate of ¼ of 1% of the value of the endowment, as long as the Foundation's General Endowment Investment reaches 12%, net of fees. The monies will be invested in the Foundation's cash management account or other similar low-risk investment vehicle.

Having a reserve account will provide fiscal stability for the Foundation and help it meet pressing and unforeseen needs of the University during times of diminishing resources.





Patricia Smith Ranzoni initiated this fund in honor of her advisor, Stanley L. Freeman. The details of the fund description have not yet been finalized.

Norman Stetson helped found Inframetrics (now known as FLIR Systems, Inc.), a company that produces innovative thermal imaging systems including infrared cameras.

Gerald Stoughton '37 and his wife Harriet established this fund in memory of William F. Scamman and Christine Shaw Scammon with the proceeds from a pooled income fund. Scholarships will be given to engineering and/or computer science students.

Arline K. Thomson Fogler Library Fund

Arline Thomson, a talented artist for more than 70 years who passed away in 2010, established this fund with a bequest. The fund shall support the most pressing needs of the Fogler Library.

Robert B. Thomson Honors Center Fund

Memorial gifts and a bequest from Arline K. Thomson established this fund in honor of Arline's husband, Robert. Robert Thomson was a professor, political scientist, and revered former director of the Honors Program. The fund will support pressing needs of the Honors Center, which bears his name.

This fund was established by family and friends of Hugh Violette '05 who passed away in 2011. Scholarship recipients shall be forest resource students.

Professor George Wadlin Memorial Scholarship

Friends of the Men's Ice Hockey program established this fund with the net proceeds from annual golf events in honor of William (Shawn) Walsh.
