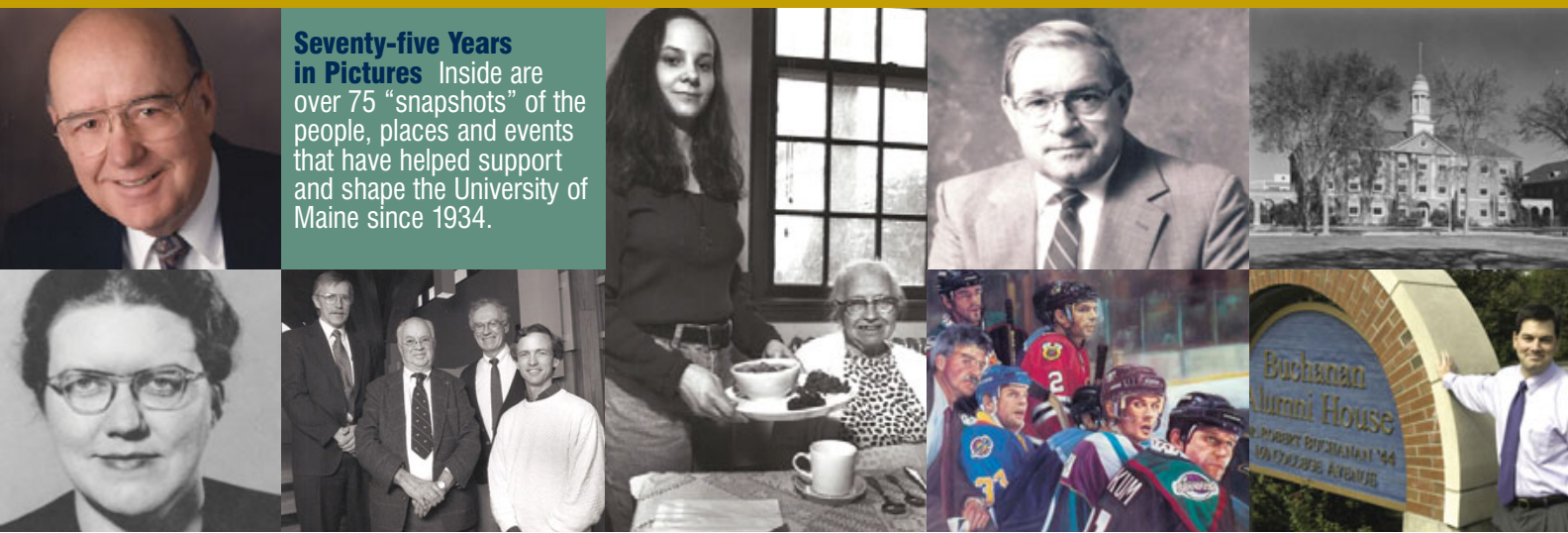

From the **Board Chair and President/CEO**

The date was June 9, 1934—the height of the great depression. University President Harold Boardman called a meeting of charter members of the University of Maine Foundation where they adopted a statement of purpose and a set of bylaws. That evening, with a gift from the class of 1909, the Foundation was established.

Seventy-five years later, the University of Maine Foundation manages an endowment of approximately \$110 million and has assets of \$149 million. Since 1975, it has paid over \$75 million to support University of Maine programs, students and faculty—nearly two-thirds of that amount supporting student scholarships.

The Foundation was created in 1934 during a period of financial uncertainty. Ironically, in our 75th year since incorporation, the challenges are not dissimilar. But, we are now living in a global economy. We are affected not only by what happens on Wall Street, but also what happens in Beijing or London, or even Reykjavik.

Like other colleges and universities, our endowments have suffered, but the Foundation continues to remain confident in its long-term investment policies, which call for diversification to enhance returns and reduce risk.

And, despite tough times, our donors have been generous. During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, total gifts processed were 1,956 amounting to \$7,748,262. This is a considerable decrease compared to our average of \$11 million and is a reflection of the weak economy and the decline in the stock market.

Forty years ago, tuition for Maine students was \$400—today, tuition is over \$9,000 for in-state students and predicted to rise even higher. To ensure that deserving students have the opportunity to further their education, the Foundation has set a goal of raising \$800 million in endowed funds during the next 75 years. This is a reasonable goal, and if successful, we could fulfill the unmet need of every UMaine student in only one generation.

Over the past 75 years, the funds that the University of Maine Foundation has provided to students have touched many lives, providing opportunities that may have gone unfulfilled without a little leg up. One such student, Joanne Lynch, tells her story so eloquently we asked her to represent the thousands of students who have benefited from the generosity of our many wonderful benefactors. In the next two pages, you'll read Joanne's story. We hope that you are as inspired by her words as we were.

In closing, we offer special thanks to you, our alumni and friends, for your private support of UMaine. The gift of education is one of the greatest legacies one can bestow.

Education is opportunity. On the occasion of our seventy-fifth anniversary, this story is a reminder of everything a student has to gain when support is available.

2 As a child, I channeled my hopes through the blunt end of a black crayon. I spent hours drawing and dreamed of becoming an artist. In high school, following the footsteps of my two older sisters who had gone on to college, I felt extreme pressure to succeed. I did my best, but I shined only in art class. When I applied to colleges, I was rejected by all of them. Hurt by that failure, I gave up the idea of ever being academically successful. I honestly believed that I was stupid. I abandoned my dream of becoming an art teacher and threw my portfolio in the trash, destroying two years of work.

Over the years I worked as a nurse's aid, telephone operator, service representative, truck driver, and nursery school teacher. I also fell in love, got married, and had a son. When he was diagnosed with Asperger's Syndrome, I taught myself about the condition and became his

advocate. As a parent, I faced many roadblocks regarding his treatment and education. This adversity fostered strength, courage, and resolve within both of us. It was also preparation for a devastating blow: after 23 years of marriage, my husband left. The divorce impacted everyone in our family. The wounds ran deep, but I needed to move on, with serious decisions to make. If I wanted to provide my son with the support he would need beyond high school, I needed to find better employment. My chances looked grim without a college education.

I decided to enter the University of Maine through the Onward program. I still did not consider myself “smart”; I just wanted to obtain a degree, in the least challenging major, to secure a better life for my son and me. I thought I could skimp by— just enough to graduate. In the first few months, as I began to receive good grades, I attributed it to luck or a professor’s kindness. Then one day in English class, something wonderful happened. Staring, in shock, at an A+ exam grade, I finally perceived myself as intelligent. It was a joyful, powerful moment in my life. From that point on, buoyed by the skills I learned in my Onward orientation class, I excelled. At the end of my first semester at the University of Maine, I achieved a GPA of 4.0. I am now about to graduate with a GPA of 3.86 with two bachelor degrees: women’s studies and psychology.

Everyone has dreams, but not everyone can afford them, or gets the chance to live them. Mine would never have been possible without scholarships. I’m thankful for every day I spent in college and what I learned, academically and personally. Those who provided support gave me the opportunity to fulfill my dreams and the inspiration to empower others.

Over 90 scholarships and funds have been established in the UMF through alumni class gifts.

The Ira C. Darling trust has played a significant role in providing match funding for \$5 million in National Science Foundation grants for buildings, research equipment and other infrastructure needs for the Darling Marine Center in Walpole.

1992 Partnership with Alumni Association to build Buchanan Alumni House was completed in 2002 using no public funds. Over 14,000 alumni and friends contributed to the building and endowment.

The Charles E. Gilbert Loan fund makes low-interest loans totaling several hundred thousand dollars annually to UMaine graduates who are in medical, dental or veterinary school, to help finance their professional studies.

A variety of assets can be used to establish a planned gift. From cash to real estate to tangible personal property, the Foundation staff is ready to assist you and your advisors to find the best fit for your personal circumstances.

Perhaps the most common form of a planned gift is through a bequest. If you wish to leave the University of Maine Foundation a bequest in your will or trust for a scholarship or some other purpose, you can amend your will or trust to reflect your wishes. The following represents sample language for doing so.

"I give and bequeath to the University of Maine Foundation for the University of Maine (possible choices below)

- *the sum of \$ _____; or*
- *_____ percent of my estate; or*
- *the property described herein to establish (or benefit if already existing) the _____ Fund. The principal of said Fund is to be endowed and only the income earned on the principal shall be used to provide financial assistance."*

For those individuals that have additional charitable interests outside the University of Maine, the Foundation will help you establish a donor-advised fund. This is a cost-effective alternative to a private family foundation and allows you to consolidate and manage all of your charitable giving.

Planned gifts change the lives of the donors who make them and the students who benefit from them. Your support will enable students of every background and ambition at the University of Maine, from first-generation college enrollees to dedicated graduate researchers, to reach their goal while continuing to make the University of Maine a leader in higher education.

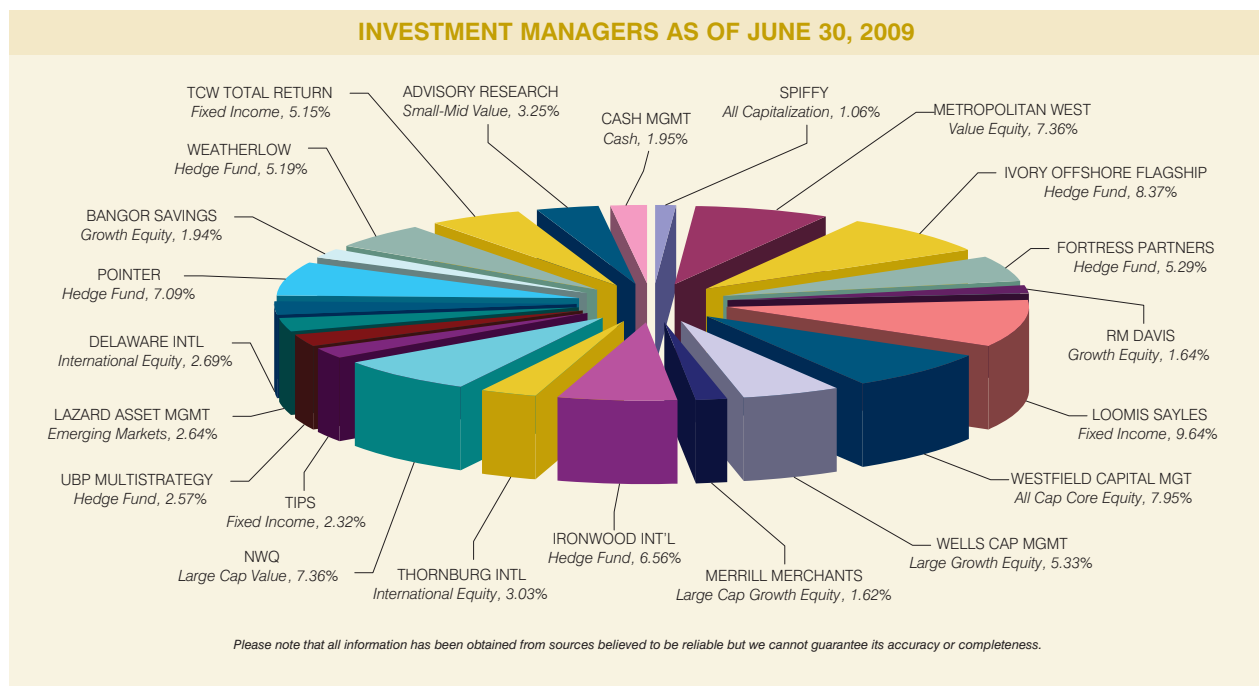


Endowment Funds Financial Review

The General Endowment Fund of the University of Maine Foundation is a pool of over 1,200 permanently endowed and quasi-endowed funds. The Foundation's objective in managing its endowed funds is to generate an income stream for distribution to the University and provide for adequate growth in the endowments. To facilitate the achievement of these goals, the Foundation operates the General Endowment Fund on a total return basis, which focuses on the overall return of the investment portfolio including both investment income (interest and dividends) and capital appreciation (realized and unrealized). Under the total return basis, an endowment spending rate of the invested assets is established versus only spending from interest and dividend income.

The Foundation's spending rate as established by its board of directors is 5.5% of the six-year average fair-market value of the investment pool. To provide for the accumulation of earnings, only endowment funds that have been in the General Endowment at least one year will be eligible for spending.

For permanent endowments, spending is contingent upon the fund accumulating sufficient earnings to support the calculated spending amount. The Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) was recently enacted by the Maine Legislature and permits expenditure from endowed funds even if the fund's value is less than its principal or historic dollar value. The Foundation Board of Directors believes that the donors who established endowed funds with the Foundation intended to create funds according to the dictionary definition of endowment, meaning that the principal of the fund would not be invaded for distribution. Donors who create new funds will have the option of creating a fund in which principal may be invaded, but funds endowed in the Foundation before July 1, 2009 will not be expended if the fund's value is less than its historic dollar value, in accordance with the Foundation's spending policy.

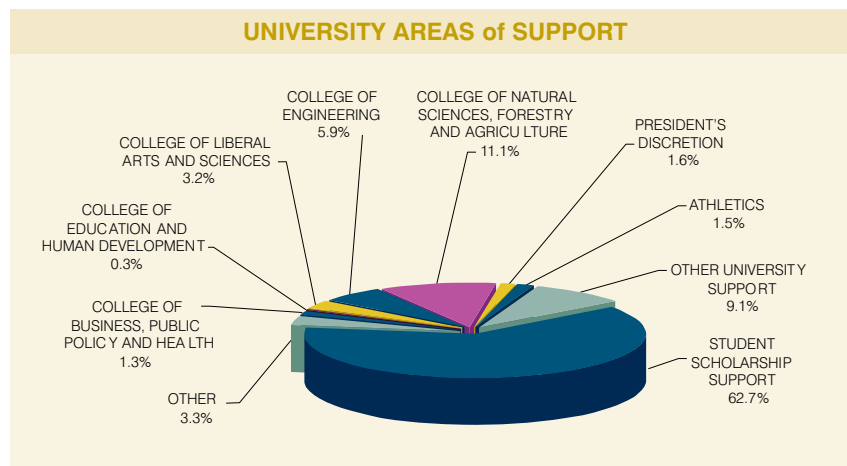

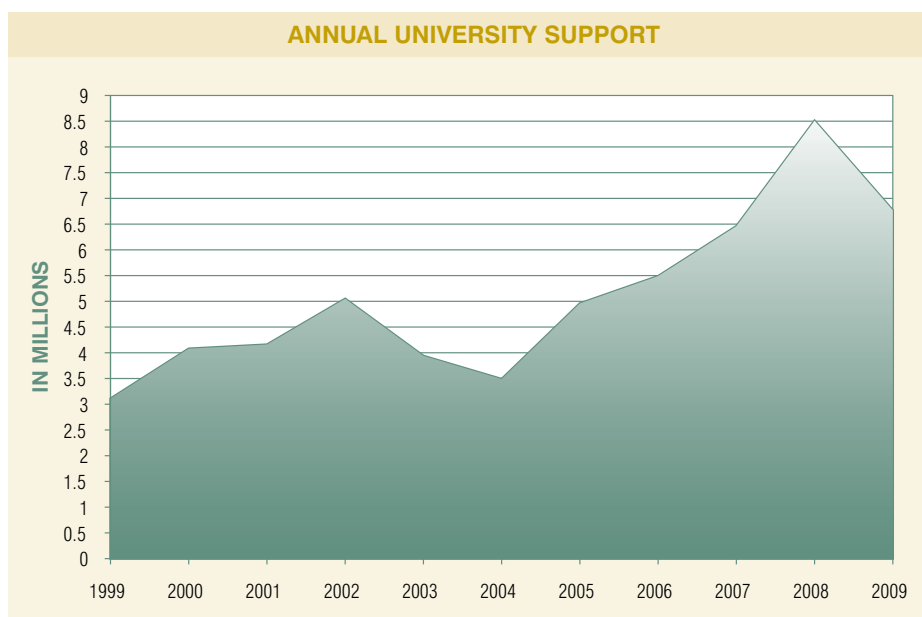

New Funds

Richard C. Alden Fund

Richard C. Alden, a member of the class of 1934, established this fund for general purposes with the early termination of a life insurance policy.

Bank of America Scholarship

Bank of America, one of the world's largest financial institutions, is committed to creating a positive change in Maine by establishing a scholarship for Maine students in good academic standing with financial need, pursuing a business degree.

James "Red" Bell Jr.

Pike Industries, Inc. Scholarship

Pike Industries, Inc., a New England leader in the construction industry, established this scholarship in memory of a 40-year employee, James "Red" Bell, Jr., a member of the Class of 1969. In addition to other criteria, recipients must be majoring in civil engineering or construction management technology and have a high academic record.

Bernice (Bunny) Brooks Memorial Scholarship

UMaine nursing student, Randy S. Steele, established this fund in loving memory of his "adoptive" mother, Bunny Brooks. The specific details of how the fund will be used have not yet been decided.

Richard D. '35 and Dorothy D. Bucknam Scholarship

Mr. Bucknam, who passed away in April, established this fund with a charitable gift annuity. Recipients must be undergraduates enrolled in the College of Engineering with financial need, preferably from Yarmouth High School.

CES, Inc. Environmental Chemistry Laboratory Fund

CES, Inc., an engineering firm in Brewer, Maine, was founded in 1978 by Shawn Small, P.E., and Jim Parker, P.E., both members of the Class of 1970. They created this fund to support research and teaching in the environmental chemistry lab in Boardman Hall, including research on the sources, reactions, transport, effects and fates of contaminants in natural and engineered environmental systems.

Bob Churchill '53 Basketball Scholarship

This fund was created with gifts from friends and family of Bob Churchill, a member of the Class of 1953, to provide financial assistance to student-athletes who are members of the men's or women's intercollegiate basketball team.

Daniel and Betty Churchill Internship Fund in the School of Policy and International Affairs (SPIA)

The Churchills established this fund to assist SPIA students considering careers in public service or any other organizations where the primary orientation is not-for-profit service to the public, the nation or the world.

Louis S. Cleaves Fund

This fund was established with the annual earnings from a charitable trust created by Mr. Cleaves for general purposes.

Pamela Jean Collins Nursing and Education Fund

This fund was established with a bequest from Pamela Jean Collins for nursing or education students with financial need in good academic

standing. Ms. Collins was a summer resident of Maine who lost her life in 2008 after a fierce battle with cancer.

Mark S. and Melaine Cross CHE Excellence Fund

Mr. and Mrs. Cross established this fund to support student research, equipment and materials essential for intercollegiate competitions in the chemical and biological engineering program. Mr. Cross, a member of the Class of 1979, is Senior Vice President of MeadWestvaco, and is a member of the UM Pulp & Paper Foundation.

Frances M. Donovan '43 Student Recreation and Fitness Center

This fund was established by Fran's daughters, Anne Bodnar and Jeanne Fisher, in memory of their mother in recognition of her love for the University and commitment to sports, fitness, friendship and community. The fund will support the Student Recreation and Fitness Center and, particularly, the Donovan Lobby at the Center.

David L. Dorr Forestry Fund

This fund was created with proceeds from a parcel of land given by Mr. Dorr in 2001. The fund will assist with the management, maintenance, equipment and supplies of forestlands owned by the University and the Foundation.

James E. Elliott '51 Fund

Mr. Elliott, a member of the Class of 1951 who passed away earlier this year, established this fund with the assets from a pooled life income fund. One half of the fund supports the Class of 1951 Scholarship and the other half provides unrestricted assistance for the mechanical engineering program.

Harold E. Farmer Scholarship

Muriel Farmer established this fund with a bequest in memory of her husband, Harold. Mr. Farmer graduated from Maine with two degrees in physical education, a B.S. in 1949 and a M.Ed. in 1954. This fund will support financially needy students wishing to pursue a degree in secondary education.

Walter H. Foster III Fund

Walter H. Foster III, a member of the Class of 1977, established this fund through a bequest to support mechanical engineering scholarships, engineering facilities and mechanical engineering professors.

Fourth of July Society Fund

Established by alumni who recognize the value of a strong, independent alumni association, the fund will support the operational expenses of the Association.

Lionel & Germaine Gagnon Memorial Fund

Lee Gagnon, a member of the Class of 1959, established this fund to support the Fogler Library in memory of his parents, Lionel and Germaine, in recognition of their unconditional love, support and encouragement.

Roger D. Gould '52 Senior Design Project Innovation Fund

Mr. Gould, a member of the Class of 1952 and a professional engineer, established this fund for innovative electrical and computer engineering senior design projects.

Chenoweth Hall Scholarship

Miriam A. Colwell '39 established this fund in honor of her friend who

was a talented sculptor and artist. The recipients must be art majors enrolled at either the Orono or the Machias campus. Preference will be given to graduates of Sumner Memorial High School, or any high school in Hancock or Washington counties.

Edward C. Hall '48 and Dorothy Moran Hall '43 Scholarship

Mr. Hall, an engineering major and retired entrepreneur, and Mrs. Hall, a retired French teacher, who were parents of six, established this scholarship for education majors.

Mary Christine & Paul E. Hayes Memorial Scholarship

This fund was established by Dr. Maura Hayes Emerson '74, '78G, successful Navy career officer and physician, in honor of her parents. The awards will be given to 1st-year students from Brewer High School who demonstrate financial need.

Kathleen R. Hill Scholarship

Al McNeilly '44 established this fund in honor of Kathy Hill in recognition of her ability to make guests feel welcome at Buchanan Alumni House. Recipients must have been involved in the food service industry.

William R. and Mary C. Hilton Trust

This scholarship was established with the remaining assets from a pooled life income fund created by William R. Hilton '39 and Mary Carlisle Hilton '43. The recipients shall be civil engineering majors who demonstrate financial need.

Jane Holmes Fund

Jane Holmes established this fund through her estate plans. The fund will benefit four areas: Littlefield Gardens; Camp Tanglewood; Page Farm and Home Museum; and the Roger Luce Scholarship.

Doris Roberts, H. Lawrence, and George Lawrence Humphrey 4-H Scholarship

Gene Doris Humphrey established this fund in memory of Doris R. Humphrey, H. Lawrence Humphrey, and George L. Lawrence for a 4-H student pursuing post-secondary education.

Marcia Smargon Kornetsky Sociology Prize

Conan Kornetsky, Ph.D., '48 established this fund in loving memory of his wife Marcia, a member of the Class of 1948, together with children David and Lisa. The award will be given to an outstanding graduating sociology major.

Olive B. Landry and Barbara A. Dennett Scholarship

Barbara Dennett '45, '62G, who passed away in 2008, created this fund in memory of Olive B. Landry '44 with the proceeds from a pooled life income fund. Scholarship recipients must be graduates of Bonny Eagle High School in Standish, Maine.

Dr. Waldo "Mac" Libbey '44 Professorship in Electrical & Computer Engineering

Dr. Libbey, a member of the Class of 1944 who passed away this year, will fully fund this professorship through his estate plans for electrical and computer engineering faculty support.

Louis E. Lipphardt Sr. Mechanical Engineering Scholarship

Mr. Lipphardt, a member of the Class of 1948, established this fund

through a charitable remainder trust for mechanical engineering majors. The recipients should demonstrate financial need and academic merit.

MALSCE SVT Scholarship

A gift from the Massachusetts Association of Land Surveyors and Civil Engineers created this fund to assist undergraduates majoring in surveying engineering technology with financial need, preferably from Massachusetts.

Alphege (Bo) '58 & Constance Atherton Martin '60 Fund

Constance Martin '60 created this fund in honor of her husband Alphege (Bo), a member of the Class of 1958. Mr. Martin excelled in sports and this fund will assist juniors in good academic standing who play football or basketball.

Richard and Arlene McCrum Scholarship

Dr. McCrum received his master's of science degree in botany in 1953 and created this fund with the assets remaining from charitable gift annuities established in prior years. The fund will assist academically promising students majoring in art.

Alvin S. McNeilly Advanced Engineered Wood Composite Center Fund

Al McNeilly, a member of the Class of 1944, established this fund for unrestricted support for the director of the Advanced Engineered Wood Composite Center.

Henriette C. Murphy Scholarship

This fund was created to honor Henriette Murphy for her 40 years of working with disabled people in Belgium by her sister, Paula Peer; her niece, Annie Norton; and Stephen Norton. Awards will be given to disabled students who demonstrate financial need and academic merit.

Musgrave Scholarship Fund

This scholarship was initiated by Katherine Musgrave '74, 2006H, to support graduate dietetic interns in the second year of their program who demonstrate financial need and academic merit. Dr. Musgrave is an enthusiastic champion of nutrition and good health and continues to counsel the campus community and beyond.

Olver Associates established this fund to support and name the environmental microbiology laboratory in Boardman Hall for the civil and environmental engineering program.

William S. Reid '28 and Ruth B. Reid Scholarship
