#### Preface

The purpose of this report is to give a comparative picture of the distribution of lawyers throughout the state. The statistics concerning the number of lawyers, their ages, years of service and education are taken from the 19h7 Martindale-Hubbell directory. The information is not entirely accurate. The list includes some lawyers now deceased; those most recently admitted to the bar are not included, and a varying number are inactive. However, the same, or about the same, conditions will exist in all communities with the result that a reasonably accurate comparative picture for the entire state is given.

The figures given do not attempt to eliminate those lawyers listed in the directory who are primarily engaged in activities other than the active practice of law. The number undoubtedly is substantial in the larger cities. The actual ratio of population to the lawyers in those cities thereby become higher. On the other hand in the smaller counties one and perhaps more lawyers will be devoting all or a large portion of their time to the duties of judge or prosecuting attorney with the result that the ratio of population to the lawyers would be actually higher than that shown.

The source of the property values given is the report of the Auditor of State for the year 1945, the latest figure available in the most recent Indiana Yearbook. The figures being based on tax assessment value and as of three years ago are low; however, except for an unprecedented development in a given county a fair basis for comparison is given.

Those indicated as being I.U: graduates include those showing an LL.B. degree from either the University Law School or the Indiana Law School. The figures indicating the county income ("Effective Buying Income") best disclose the business condition of the county today. They are from the May 1948 issue of <u>Sales Management</u>. In arriving at the figures given the best available 19h7 census estimates and the May 19h8 wage and salary scales were used.

In appraising the attractiveness of a location the Martindale ratings are significant, that is, how many "a" and "b" lawyers are there in the community? Note that a lawyer is not rated "a" short of ten years, or "b" short of five years of practice. The number not rated may be more significant.

The total lawyer population of Indiana (based on 1947 Martindale-Hubbell) is 3,786. The estimated Indiana population in 1947 was 3,889, 800. The population per lawyer was 1,027.

From 1932 through 1939 admissions to the bar in Indiana averaged 180 per year. This was, according to the experts, no more than a normal replacement. Admission figures for 1940-48 are as follows:

On the basis of a normal number of admissions (180 each year for the nine year period) there is a deficit, as of 1949, of 794 admissions. There is now a substantial shortage of lawyers in Indiana, and it is doubtful if that deficit will ever be made up.

In the pages that follow: (c.s.) means county seat; (a) gives the name of a lawyer in the county (located in the county seat unless otherwise indicated, and in most instances a graduate of I.U.) who will be helpful to one interested in locating in that county or city. This information is included only where no recent graduates are available, or only a limited number are listed. In a few instances we are not familiar with any of the lawyers in the county and reference is made to lawyers in an adjoining county; (b) lists all recent graduates of I.U., beginning with the class of 1942, who (to the best of our knowledge) have entered the practice in that county.
