## DECLARATION AND ORDINANCE Of the LORDS and COMMONS Affembled in Parliament,

For the better fecuring and fetling of the peace of the County of Kent, and for enabling them to aflociate with the City of London, or any other Counties adjacent. And to raife Forces within the faid County, as well Horfe as Foot, and therewith to give, or caufe battell to be given to all fuch forces as are or thal be raifed without the confect of both houfes of Parlizment, and all fuch perfons with their Abbettors and Adherents to invade, refift, put to flight, purfue, supprefie, kill, flay, put to execution of death, and by all means to deftroy, as enemies to the Kingdom.

Likewife, Instructions for the Lord-Lieutenant, Deputy-Lieutenants, and other Offiers, and Commanders in the County of Kent. And, that every perfon which shall be imployed as Souldiers in this services of the age of 16. yeers and upwards, shall solemnly take an Outh, to be approved of by the Parliament, and they that wilfully neglect the same shall be proceeded against as Delinquents, and enemies of the peace of the Kingdom.

alleciated themlelbes in this kingdome, for the utter ertirpation of the true Protestant well affected party therein; And for that end have railed and daily doe raile great forces both of Porte and fort, and have plundered, spoyled, and destroged multitudes of Wis Majesties god Subjects, using allo their utmost endeavours to bying into their affishance forraigners of their owne fraction. All which if not speedily prebented will utterly subvert the true Protestant Beligion, (which is their chiefe deligne) the Lawes of the Land, the priviledges of Parliament, and the Liberty of the Subject : for the timely preventing and withstanding of which milthebe been and fill are desirous to have a confiderable modeing body of Porte and fort railed and maintained at the charge

tharge of the faid County, and to enter into allociation for the mutuall defence and preferbation of the prace of the faid County, and of all chofe that thall topne with them therein : The faid Lozds and Commons doe thereupon declare that they bold it a thing most fit and necessary for the pretent state of the hingdome, and fecurity of the faid County of Kenis and do ozdaine and declare, and be it ozdained and declared by the faid Lozds and Commons, that the Lozd Lieutenant and Deputy lieutenants, Collonels, Captaines, and other Officers that are of thall be imployed in the laid County of Kent, the County and Eity of Canterbury, and Cinque posts, with their members, and all other well afferted persons inhabitants in them, og any of them, fhall and may affociate them. felves each with other, and with all those who thall enter ins to the Caid Affociation; and that the faid Lozo lieutenant and Deputy-lieutenants, og any leben og moge of them, fog the forefaid ends and purpoles, and allo for the forcing and compelling refractory perfons to yeeld obedience unto the Diders and Didinances of either og both Poules of Parlia ment, shall have full Power and Authozity, and are hereby auchoziled to raife, atme, and maintaine a mobing body of fot, confifting of one Thouland og moze Uoluntiers, whereof some to be of the Trained bands; and one of more Trope or Trupes of Horfe which now are or bereafter thall be fubleribed oz otherwile pzovided within the faid County, whereof none allo are to be taken out of the Cramed Fozces : And alfo to nominate, conflitute, and appoint a Maio? Br. netall over the faid forces, and to give full power and authority to the faid Maior Benerall, in cafe of fickneffe or dif ability of body, from time to time to conflictute and appoint in his dead fuch trufty and able perfon as be thall thinke fit to be his Deputy, and in his ablence to doe all things belon-Ating to the Office of a Maioz Generall : and the fast Lozdlieutenant, and Deputy-Lieutenants, o2 any seaben o2 2 2

moze of them, thall be, and are hereby authoriced to Confit tute and appoint Collonels, Lieuten unt-collonels, Serieant. mators, Captames, and other Officers over the faid forces: and from time to time, in and into all convenient places to Leade, Condud, Quarter, and Exercice, og caule to be lead, conducted, quartered, and exerciced, the faid forces, of any part ebereof, and there with to give of caufe battaile to be given to all fuch forces as are or thall be ratted against, or without authority or confent of both Houses of Parliament, or that thall make or endeabour to make any Javalion, Bas piae, Tumult, of Infurrection, of for 11 plunder, pillage, of deftroy any of His Mateftes good Subicits, 3nd all and fingular luch perfons, their abbettoes, and adherents, to inbase, refilt, put to flight, purfue, suppresse, kill, flip, put to erecution of death, and by all meanes to defirey as Enemies to the kingdome: And to performe, and caule to be pector med all things elle which they thall in their indigements thinke niedfull, as well fog the preferbation and lafery of the peace of the faid County and places aforefaid, as of all those which thall toyne in the said Allocation, observing the Infructions hereunto annexed, with fuch other Birections, and Commands as they thall rescribe from time to time from both Houles of Parliament, of from his Orcellency the Carlo of Effex. And be it allo Declared and Didained, by the authority aforelaid. Chat the laid Lord-Lieutenant, Deputy-lieutenants, and other Inhabitancs of the faid Country and every of them, and every other perfon which is og ligalt be imployed in that lervice, in what they have any way als ready done towards the preparing and perfecting to necellary aworke, or thall bereafter doe or performe in purfuance theres of, thall be laved and kept harmleffe by the Power and Aus though of Parliament : And the Caid Louds and Commons doe hereby Declare and Dedame, that neither the faid Rozces, noz any part of them that or may at any time be.

be removed out of the faid County without special De der and Direction from both Poules of Parliament, oz from his Eccellency the Earle of Effex, unleffe it be to the apo and affiftance of the Counties with whom they fhal enter ins to affociation, and in purfuance of their faid effociation : And for the better ordering and mannaging of the faid forces of Dorfe and fote, Be it declared and ogdained, by the authority aforelaid, That the laid Lord lieutenant, and Deputy lieute. nants, og ang feben og moge of them thall habe bereby full go: wer and authority to make, gibe and execute the fame Diners and Instructions for regulating and punisting the Officers, Cropers, and Souldiers of the faid forces, as his Crcellency the Lord Generall hath done in bis Army, and to compell them to obedience, as occasion thall require. And the berter to defend the faid County and Inhabitants thereof from all invading, plundering and pillaging, and that speedy meanes may be us fed for the furnillying and probibling of Horles, Aumes, and Ammunition, making Fortifications, payment of Officers, and other neceffary charges, And for the repayment of all fuch luns of money as are of hath bien already, of mall be advanced and fubicribed, to wards the forwarding of this worke: It is bereby declared and ordained, Chat featbluith, and from, tune to tune untill the faid forces wall by authority of both poules be disbanded, there be railed by way of tare of rate Within the fair County and places af gelaid fuch fums of moinp for the intents aforelaid, as to the Lord lieutenant, Des Durp-lieurenants, og ang feben og moge of them mall be thought tequifie and necessary : And that the Depu y Licutenants of any three or more of them after three moneths next enfung the first fellement made by bertue of this Didmance, chall i. us forthebeit febreall Zonatrants unto fuch perfons as by them og any chice of them have been og fhall he constituted and apa pointed Creafurers oz Receibirs of fuch lums of money as babe bien, og at any time hereafter, befoge the faid fellement og anp

Instructions for the Lord lieutenant, Deputy lieutenants, and others Officers and Commanders in the County of Kent, the City and County of Canterbury, and the Cinqueports, and members thereof, within the faid County of Kent.

I. THat the Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy-Lieutenants L of the faid County of Kent, of the City and County of Canterbury, the faid Cinqueports and members of the fame, or any two or more of them, doe with all convenient speed fummon the feverall Gentlemen, Freeholders, and other Inhabitants thereof, as well within the Liberties and Corporations as without, that doe beare, or are able to beare or finde Armes to fuch places in the faid Counties and places aforefaid, as they hold most fitting; and at fuch meeting to take a view of what Armes and Forces may be railed, belides the Trained-bands in the faid Counties and places, and examine the defects of Armes and Ammunition, and to confult of fome fitting course how to have the want of Armes and other defects supplied; And at such meetings, or at any other fit time or times the faid Deputy-lieutenants, or any two or more of them, fhall and may propound to all the inhabitants of the faid Counties and places aforefaid, that are able to beare or finde Armes, or to contribute towards the fame, what prefent and iminent danger and neceffity the Kingdome is now reduced unto by the wicked advice, attempts, and confpiracies of Papists, Traitors, Delinquents, and other ill affected persons, declaring themfelves against the Parliament; And to perswade and ftir them up to joyn in a mutuall defence of one another, and of all that shall affociate with them, to give, provide, furnifh nifh, lend, or advance, Horfe, Money, Plate, or Armes, towards the defence & prefervation of the peace of the faid Counties and places aforefaid, and towards the raifing furnishing and maintaining of the Forces hereby ordained to be raifed and maintained within the faid Counties and places aforefaid.

II. And for the better leavying of all fums to be affeffed and fet upon the faid Counties and places, for the defence and prefervation of the fame as aforefaid, the faid Lord lieutepant and Deputy Lieutenants of the faid Counties and places aforefaid, or any two or more of them shal and may affeste and taxe, or caufe to be affeffed and taxed the faid fum and fums upon the feverall Cities, Corporations, Lath, Rapes, Wapentakes, Hundreds, Townes, Hamlets, and Villages in the faid Counties and places aforefaid ; And that they or any two or more of them shal and may nominate and appoint Trefuters, Collectors, and Affeffors, in the faid Counties and places aforefaid, for the affeffing, receiving, and collecting fuch fum and fums of money as aforefaid ; And that the Deputy-Lieutenants or any two or more of them thall and may grant Warrants under their hands and feales in writing to any Constable, Officer, or any other perfon or perfons what foever to raife and leavy the faid funs and fums fo to be affeffed and taxed as aforefaid, by diffresse, fale of goods, or by fuch other waies or means, as to the faid Deputy lieutenants, or any two of them shal be thought requisite upon all such person and persons upon whom any fum shall be affeffed and fet as aforefaid, that do refuse or neglect to pay the fame. And in case no distresse is or may be found, then the faid Deputy-lieutenants or any two or more of them shall and may commit such perfon & perfons fo refusing & neglecting to pay as aforefaid, to fome common Goale, or to fuch other place as the faid Deputy-lieutenants or any two of them that think fit, there to remaine without baile, or mainprize, untill payment be made of fuch fum and fums as abovefaid, wherein speciall care shal be had and used that fuch fum and fums of money shall be imposed, taxed and leavied. vied upon all Papifts, Delinquents, and fuch who have either contributed nothing upon the fubferiptions & Propolitions, or very fmall and inconfiderable fums as may in proportion equall the fubferiptions and contributions of those who are wel affected and have already liberally contributed and fubferibed.

III. That all Sheriffs, Juffices of the peace, Majors, Bayliffs, Conftables, and all other His Majefties Officers, as well within Liberties as without, be from time to time aiding and afifting unto the faid Lord-lieutenant, & Deputy-lieutenants in execution of the power now or heretofore to them given by both Houfes of Parliament; And if they fhal refule or forbeare to be aiding and affifting to them therein, that the faid Lord-lieutenant and Deputy-lieutenants, or any one or more of them, fhal them apprehend and imptifon, or caufe them to be apprehended and imptifoned, or fent up to the Parliament for further punifhment as to juffice fhall appertaine.

IV. That if any perfon or perfons being nominated or appointed Selfors or Collectors by vertue of this Ordinance, fhall refué or neglect to be aiding and affilting in execution of fuch office fo enjoyned him or them, That for the first neglect of the faid fervice the faid Deputy-Lieutenants, or any two of them, fhall impose upon every fuch Collector or Selfor fo refusing or neglecting the faid Service, the fum of ten pounds by way of mulct; and for his fecond refuseall or neglect, fhall punish him with imprisonment till he shall conform himselfe.

V. That the faid Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy-Lieutenants, or any two or more of them, doe put in execution in the faid Counties and Places aforefaid, as well this prefent Ordinance and Inftructions, as other Ordinances and Infunctions formerly to them granted by both Houfes of Parliament, for raifing of Money upon the Propositions, for the executing of the Militia, difarming of Papifts and other ill affected perions, or any other Ordinance or Inftructions of

of both Houfes heretofore granted to them & now in force; And for that purpofe, that they, or any two, or more of them, fhal have power and au hority to Arm, Exercise, Train, and put in readineffe, as well all and every the trained Bands and Troops of the faid Counties and Places aforefaid, and other Voluntiers both of Horfe and Foot, as the faid Forces of Horfe and Foot railed or to be raifed, or maintained by vertue of this prefent Ordinance, as aforefaid, and them under the command of fuch Colonels, Lieutenant-Colonels, Sergeant-Majors, Captains, and other Officers, as from time to time being nominated by the faid Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy Lieutenants, or any three or more of them, as shall be approved of or appointed to lead and conduct the faid Forces, as well against all forraigne Power that shall in hostile manner invade the faid Counties, as also against all other Forces which shall be either within the faid Counties and Places aforefaid, or elf-where raifed to the disturbance of the Peace thereof, or which shall fand in opposition to the Orders, Commands, and Ordinances of both Houfes of Parliament. And if any perfon or perfons whatfoever shall leavie, or en deavour to leavie, or billet any Souldiers, or raife, draw forth, or keepe together the trained Bands of the faid Counties and places, or other armed Forces thereof by colour or pretence of any Commission, Warrant or Authority from his Majefty under the great Seale, or otherwife, without order or confent of both Houses of Parliament, That they the Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy-Lieutenants, and every of them, are to make knowne to the faid Trained-bands and Forces aforefaid, and other Inhabitants of the (aid Counties and places aforefaid, that those who shall appeare upon any fuch Warrant, or obey any fuch Commission shall bee held enemies to the publique peace; And those that shall not appeare upon any fuch Warrant and Commission, nor doe any thing in ex-cution thereof, but conforme and submit themselves to the Ordinance of the Militia, and to this Ordinance and the Inftructions thereupon, shall be protected by both Houses of Parliament, and alfo B

alfo fhall make known to the faid Inhabitants, That it hath ever been, and fill fhall be the care and endeavours of the Parlinment to provide for His Majefties fafetie; and that they do not, nor never did intend any evill against His Majesties Person, His Crown, or Dignity, that His greateft fafety is in the Aff. Ctions and fidelity of His Subjects, and in the Advice and Councell of His Perliament. And His greateft danger is in withdrawing Himfelfe from them, and joyning Himfelfe to fuch dif-affected and malignant Perfons, obnoxious to Justice for their great enorminies, who under colour of doing Hin fervice, have railed Forces which they labour to increase, to the hazard of ruining Religion and the whole Kingdom.

VI. That no Treasurer or Receiver of Money lent or affeffed towards the raifing and maintaining of these Forces shall iffue out any fuch Money, but under the hands of the Deputy Lieutenants, or two or more of them : And that the faid Deputy Lieutenants shall not figne or grant any Warrant or Warrants for the iffuing or paying of any fum or fums of Money, but for the furnishing of Horfes, Armes, and Ammunition, making Fortifications, paiment of Officers and Souldiers, or repaiment of the Money already advanced or to be advanced by loane for this Service, or other neceffary charges tending to the fafety and prefervation of the faid Counties and places aforefaid, and not

VII. That the faid Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy-Lieutenants, befides the Magazines already within the faid Counties and places aforefaid, shall out of the Monies to be raifed as aforefaid, provide and furnish fuch quantities of Arms, Ammunition, Powder, Match, and Bullet, as thell be by them, or any feven or more of them thought requisive and neceffary for the furnishing of the faid Forces both of Horfe and Foot, to be raifed, armed, and maintained by vertue of this Ordinance and Infructions, and for the fafety and neceffary defence of the faid Counties, and the fame being fo provided to be carefully kept in fome one or more Magazines for that purpole; And that as for fuch of

the

the faid Armes and Ammunion which after the disbanding of the faid Forces, as atorefaid, fhall remain, full reflication fhall be made of fo many thereof as are or thall be borrowed or lent towards the prefent arming of the faid Forces; and the refidue thereof, shall be kept and preferved in store in publike Maga-Zines for the faid Counties and places afore fiid.

VIII. That the faid Lord Lieutenant and Deputy-Lieutemants, or any one or more of them, shall take away, and cause to be taken away, the Arms, Horfes, and Moneys of all fuch perfons inhabiting within the Counties and places aforefaid, as shall refuse to contribute Money, Plate, Horfe, Men, or Arms upon the Propositions, or upon this Ordinance and Instructions, or upon any other Ordinance formerly made and now in force, or hereafter to proceed from both Houses of Parliament And that they or any two of them, shall and may in manner aforefaid, compell all Papists, Delinquents, and perfons cif affected to the Parliament, to contribute in proportion to their estates to the maintenance of the Army raifed in defence of the Parliament and Kingdome, and to the Forces tailed or to be railed by vertue of this prefent Ordinance and Inftructions.

IX. That the faid Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy-Lieutenants, and every of them, shall take care that the faid Forces of Horfe and Foot, railed or to be railed by vertue of this Ordinance and Instructions, fo long as they shall continue in the faid County, or any other County that shall affociate therein, be governed according to the Lawes and Ordinances published by his Excelleacie the Earle of Effex, and bee paid out of fuch Moneys as Thall be leavied and paid upon this Ordinance and Inft uctions,

X. That all and every perfon and perfons web are or that be imploied as Souldiers in this fervice, or web are of the age of fixteen yeers, or upwards, inhabiting in the Counties and places aforefaid, (hall for the better fecuring and uniting thereof, folemaly take fuch Covenant or Protestation, or forme of Affociation, as fh 11 be agreed upon, propounded, or approved of by the Parliament, to be taken by all perfons therein exceeding the faid age :

And that whofoever shall refuse, or wilfully neglect to take the fame, shall be taken within the intent and meaning of this Ordinance to be a Delinquent, and an enemy to the good and peace of the faid County and Kingdom, and so to be proceeded against to all intents and purposes within this and all other Ordinances and Declarations published by authority of Parliament.

XI. That to the end all Orders and Ordinances of Parliament may be better divulged. & is telligence received and given from and to the Parliament, and that the faid Lord-Lieutenant and Deputy Lieutenants may upon all occasions receive Informations concerning the state of the faid Counties and places aforefaid, and determine and advize concerning the same. It is therefore ordained, That the said Deputy Lieutenants be hereby enjoyned constantly to converne once every moneth at the least in some one convenient place of the said Countie during the time of these publique distractions.

Laftly, for the better fecuring of all fuch Inhabitants of the faid County and places aforefaid, as now are, or hereafter fhall be voted Delinquents by both Houfes of Parliament, or either of them, or which for their difobedience or contempt already, or hereafter, expressed against this or any other Ordinance of Parliament, or other proceedings thereof, or for whatfoever other caufe shall be thought fit by the faid Deputy-Lieutenants, or any two of them, to be committed and remaine in fate custor die: The faid Deputy-Lieutenants, or any two of them, are hereby authorized to apprehend, or by their Warrant caufe to be apprehended, and to commit all and fingular fuch perfons as aforefaid unto the next Goale, or to fuch other place or places as the faid Deputy-Lieutenants, or any two of them shall thinke fit.
