Settings/Participants/Resources

The **Health Sciences Library** at **Orlando Health** is a small hospital library with **3.5 FTEs**. The library provides access to print and electronic resources for approximately **18,000 hospital employees** across **8 hospital sites** throughout Central Florida. Selection of the collection was made by the Systems Librarian using **EBSCO Collection Manager**. The current collection has 16 e-audiobooks that can be accessed on-campus and off-campus through the **EBSCO Audiobooks app**.

Brief Description

The Health Sciences Library purchased leadership titles in e-audiobook format for hospital team members. Titles were selected a la carte based on team member feedback and the leadership book club selections. The titles were a one-time purchase through **EBSCO Collection Manager**. They were incorporated into the **CINAHL Complete** interface and could be searched using **EBSCO Full Text Finder**. Team members were encouraged to create a **MyEBSCO account** and download the **EBSCO Audiobooks app** to listen to the titles off-campus.

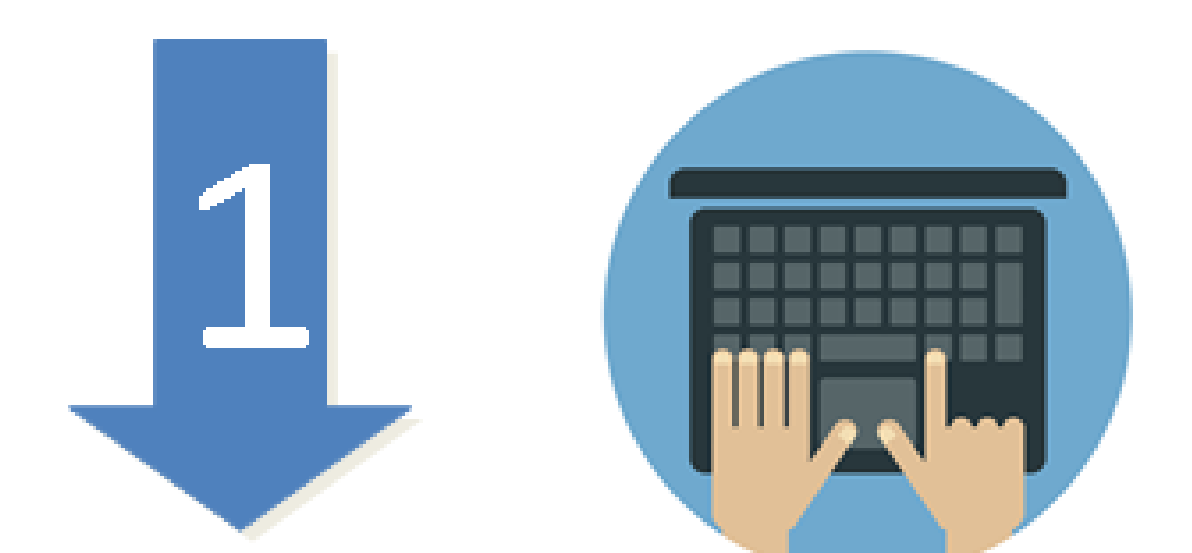

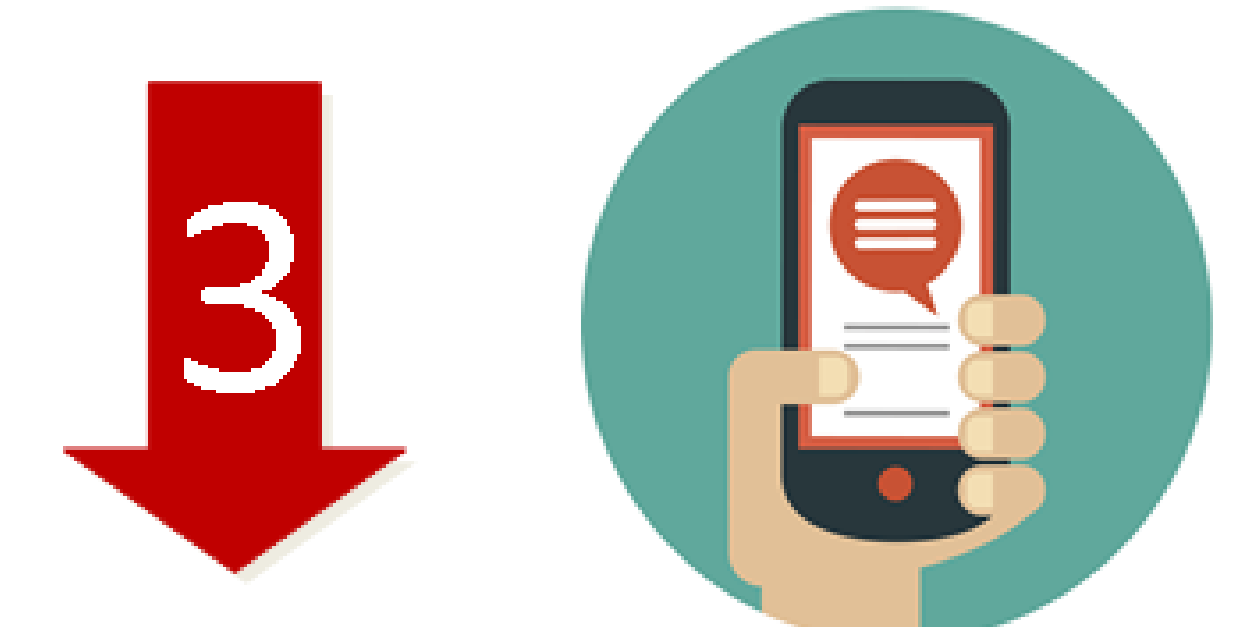
How to Download the Audiobook



1 Access e-audiobook collection on Orlando Health desktop

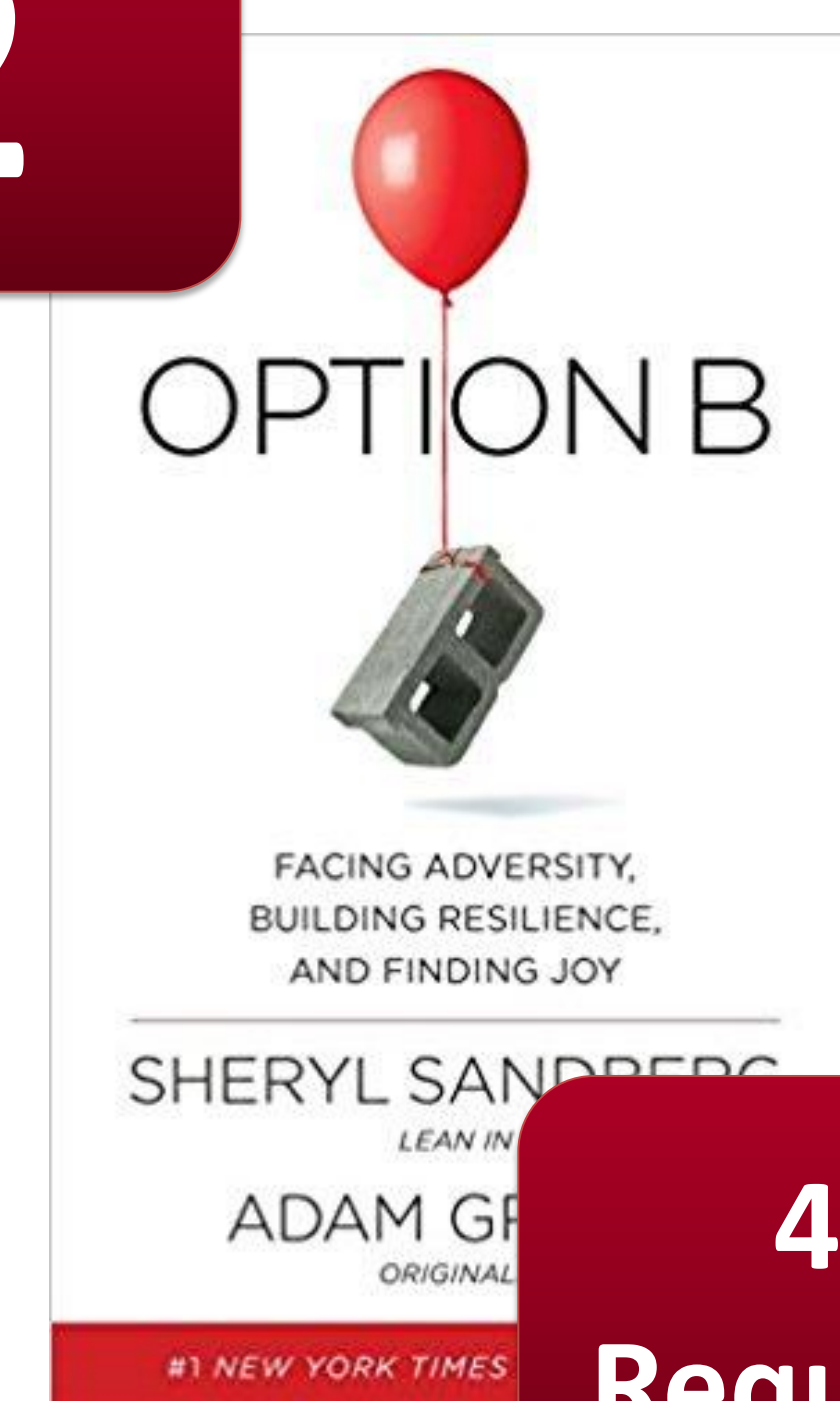


2 Locate desired title and check out to My EBSCOhost Account

Results

The collection debuted in **November 2017**. As of mid-July 2018 all **16 titles** have been accessed or checked out. From November 2017 through mid-July 2018 the three most requested titles are on the left. From **November 2017 – July 2018** the collection has received **364 total requests** since its debut.

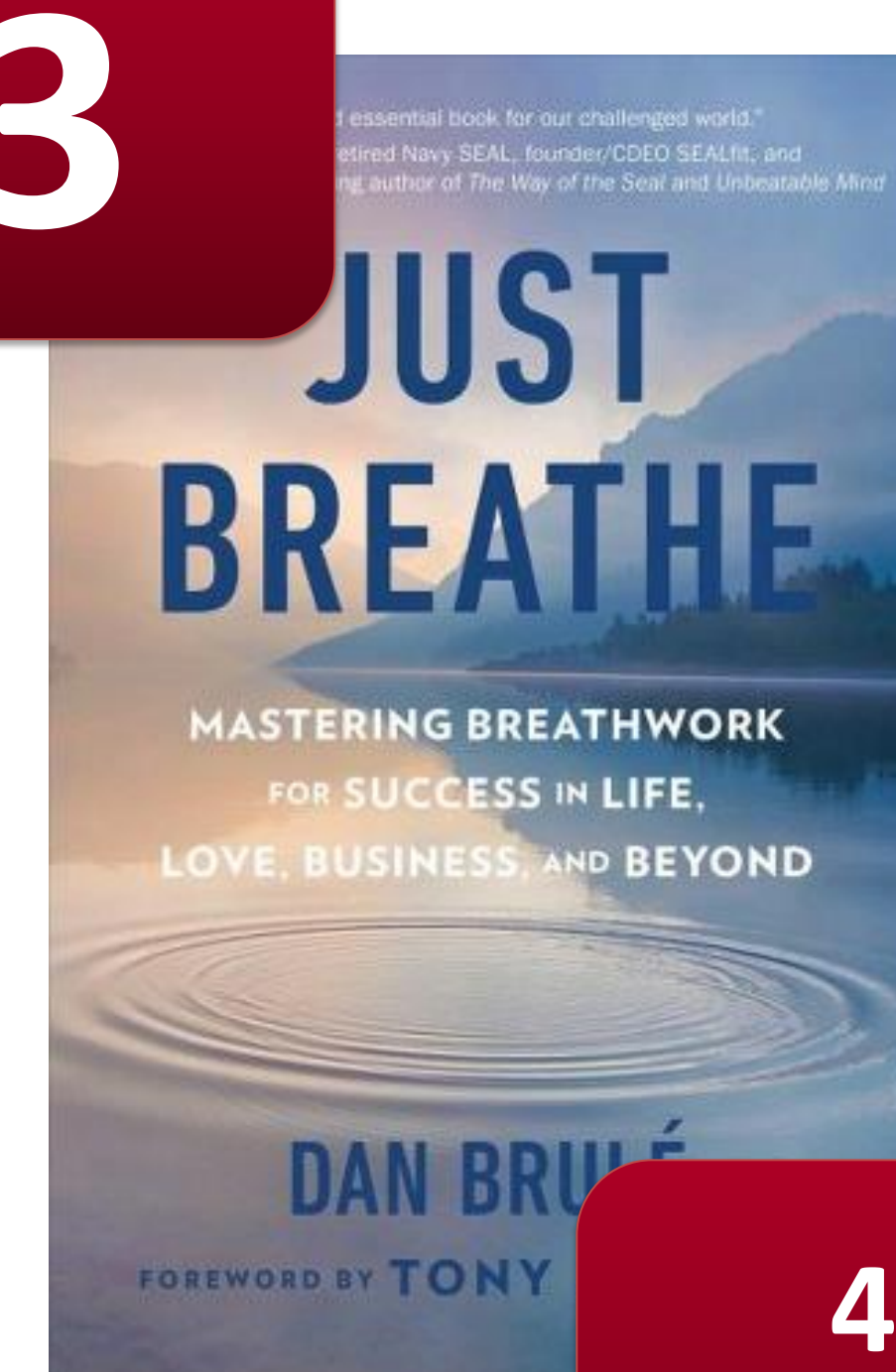
Conclusion

Lending e-audiobooks to library users is often viewed to be within the domain of public libraries. For non-traditional libraries it can be difficult to find an **affordable** and **quick-to-deploy** lending model that offers mobile app capabilities. The use of e-audiobooks proved to be an **innovative collection development decision** and **well-utilized resource** by hospital team members.
