## In Praise of Art Students

Today's fine art graduates deserve a measure of praise.

The answer is provided by George Bellows, a student of Robert Henri, the American realist painter.

"All civilization and culture are the results of the creative imagination or artist quality in man. The artist is the man who makes life more interesting or beautiful, more understandable or mysterious, or probably, in the best sense, more wonderful. His trade is to deal with illimitable experience. It is therefore only of importance for the artist to discover whether he be an artist, and it is for society to discover what return it can make to its artists."

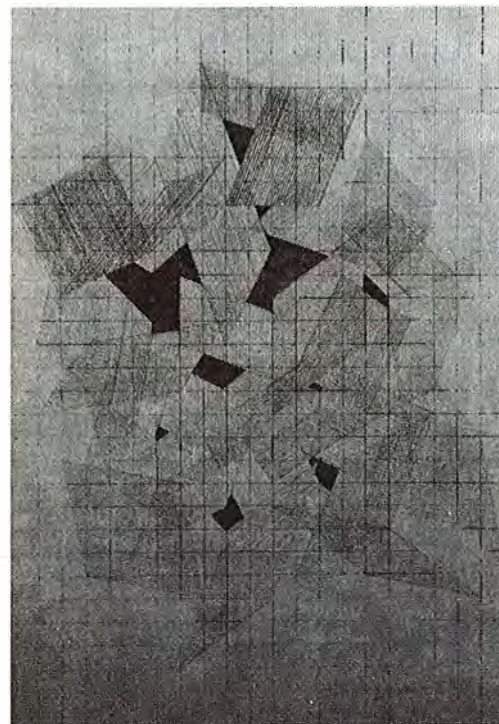

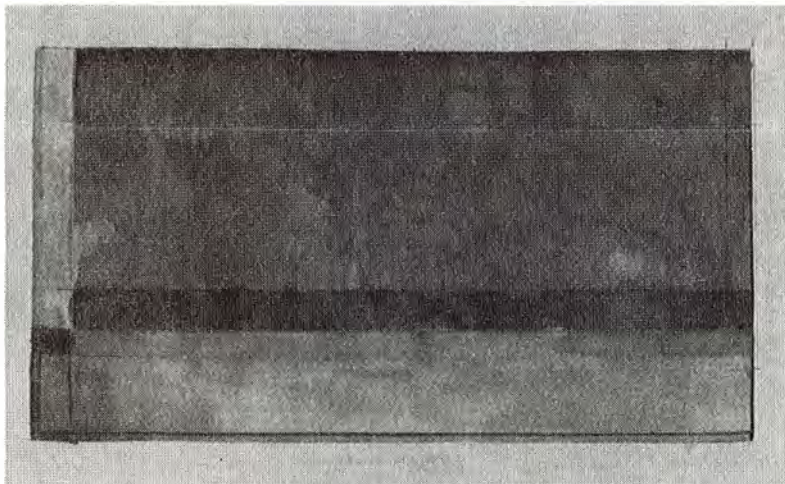

Concrete, Paint



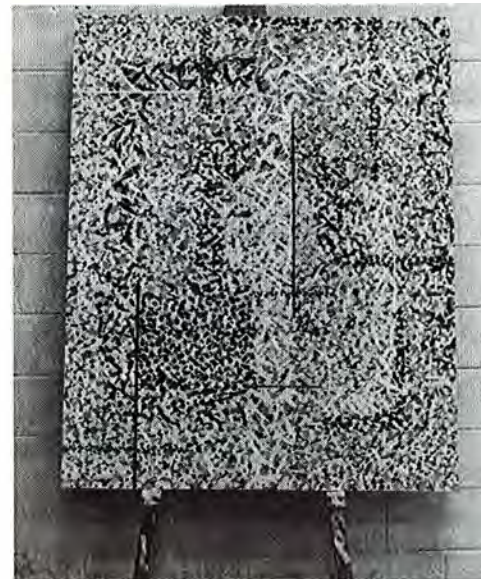

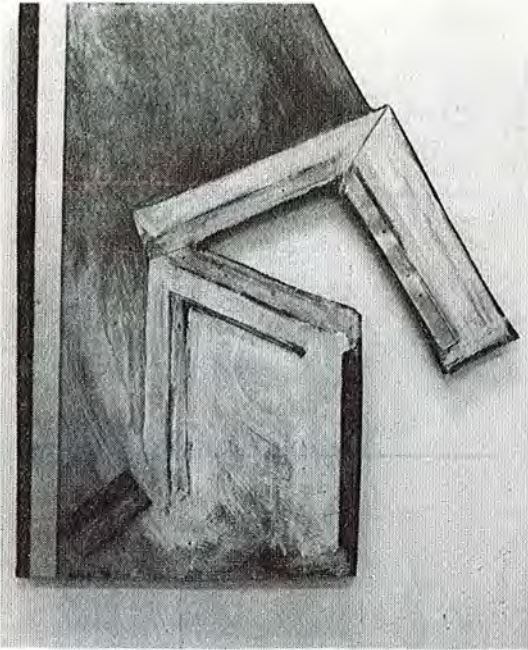

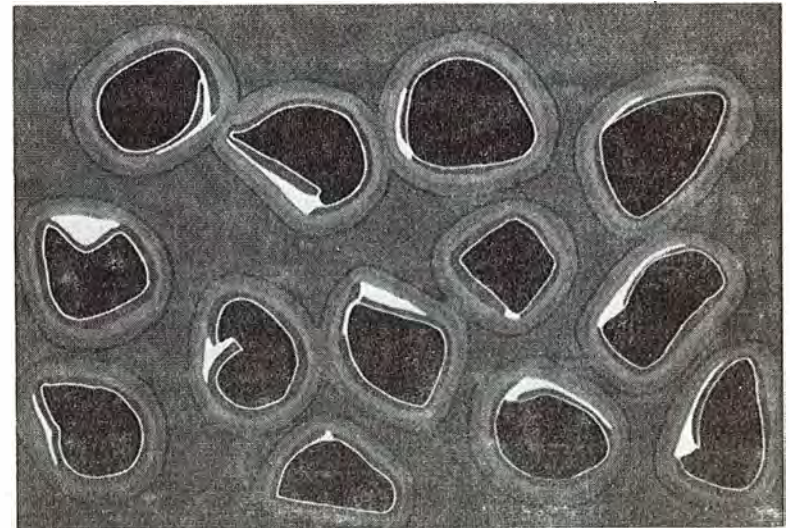

Acrylic on Canvas on Plywood

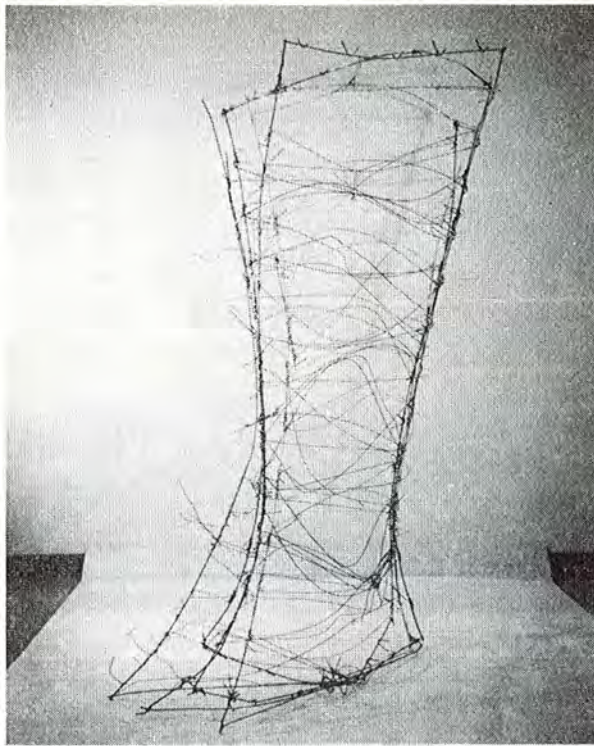

Foam and Nylon on Plywood

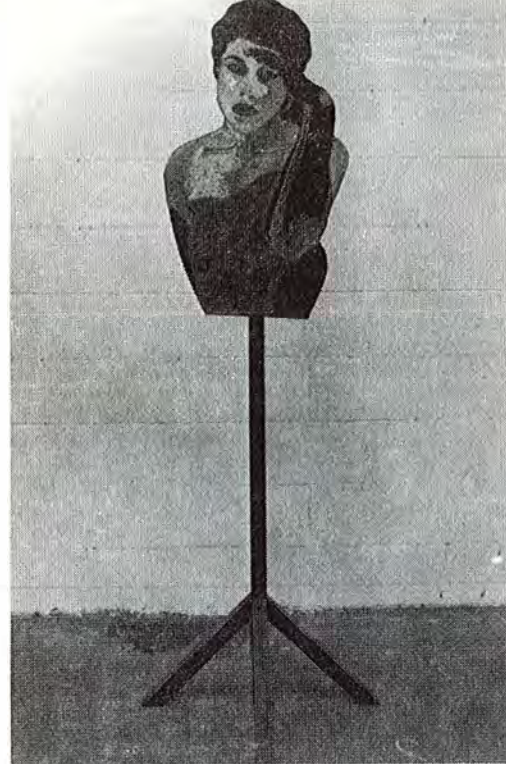

Acrylic on Wood

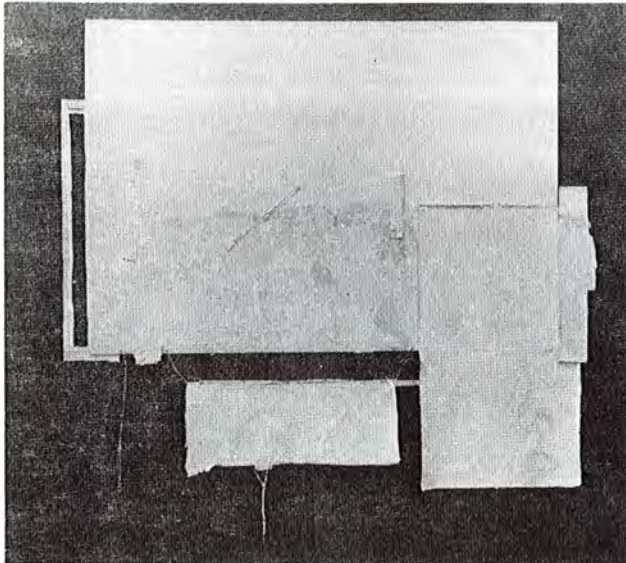

and Masonite

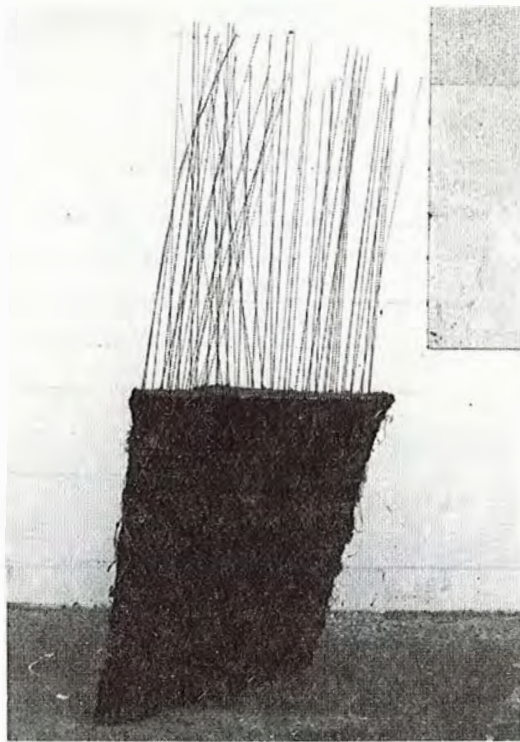

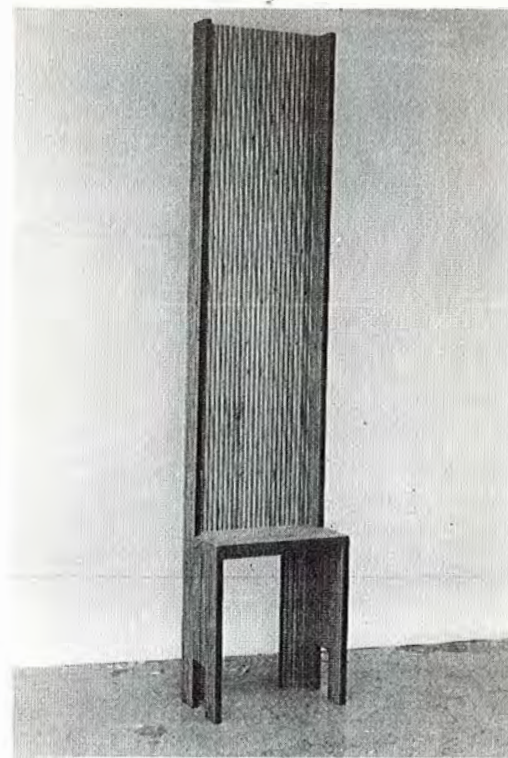

Mixed Media

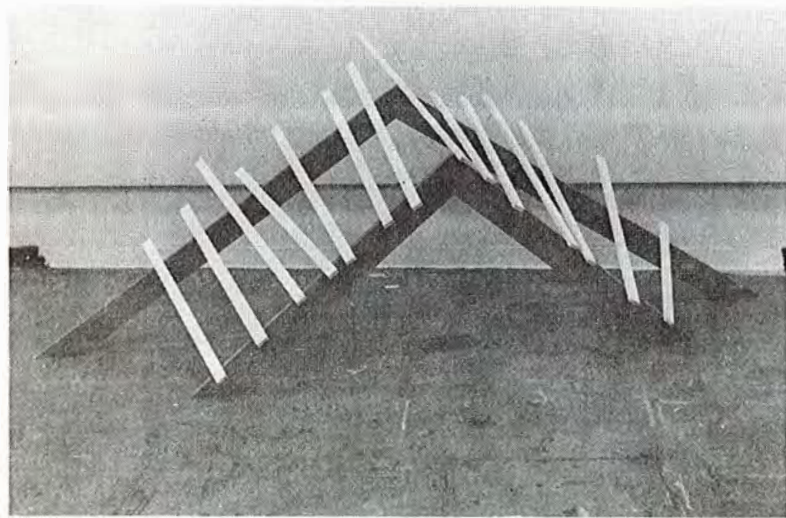
