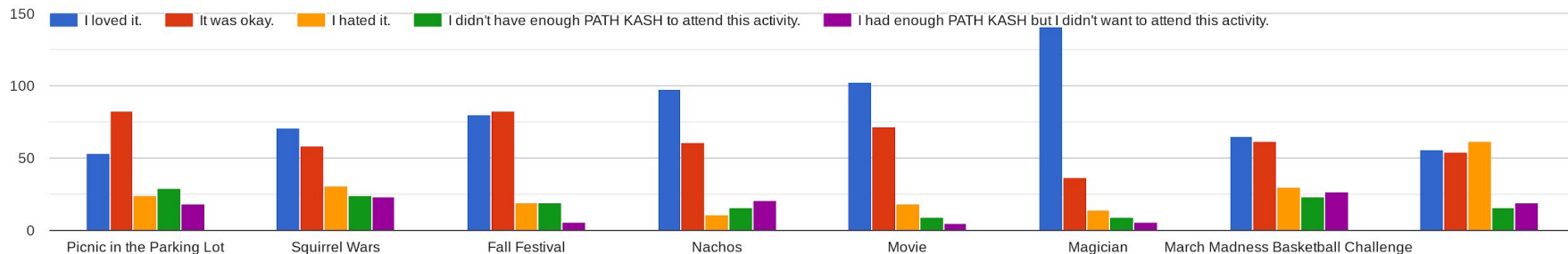
# Incentives for All

**Student Buy-In** - We promote student buy-in by offering choices and giving surveys to students.

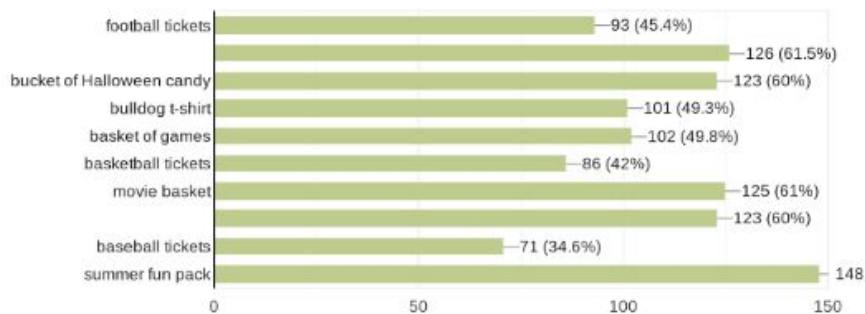
**Classroom Incentives** - Teachers can offer classroom incentives (homework pass, sit at teacher's desk, etc.)

# Student Input



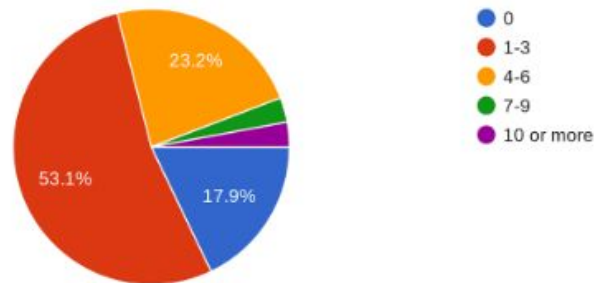
Which of the following prizes did you look forward to winning from a drawing? (You can click more than one.)

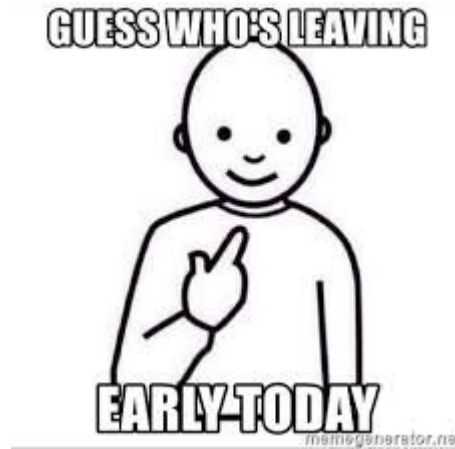
