The West Virginia Bar Association enters upon this its seventysecond year with the largest membership in its history. The current roll lists 1041 active members.

The Association feels that its recent objective of getting the West Virginia Law Review on a firm financial basis so that it may regularly publish four issues a year has been accomplished. The Association contributes eighteen hundred dollars a year to the Review. We hope to lend our efforts in the future towards assisting the Editorial Board of the Review in improving the quality of that publication, particularly in respect to having the articles therein of practical value to the West Virginia Bar. We believe the new faculty editor in charge, Mr. Stanley Dadisman, with his wide experience as an active practitioner in this state, will contribute a great deal in this direction.

The Executive Council of the Association has decided that a special project for the current year will consist of working with the commission for the revision of our state constitution. This effort will be directed towards the revision of Article VIII dealing with the Judiciary. A special committee will shortly be appointed to carry out this objective.

It is our further hope that an outstanding program may be arranged for our next annual meeting to the end that a greater number of our members may be attracted to this always happy occasion.
