

# Erratum: Rotation, spectral variability, magnetic geometry and magnetosphere of the Of?p star CPD –28° 2561<sup>★</sup>

In our paper *Rotation, spectral variability, magnetic geometry and magnetosphere of the Of?p star CPD –28° 2561* published in MNRAS, 447, 2551 (2015), an erroneous version of Fig. 10 was included that showed two rotational cycles rather than the single cycle indicated. Here, we provide the corrected figure. This substitution has no impact on the conclusions of the paper.

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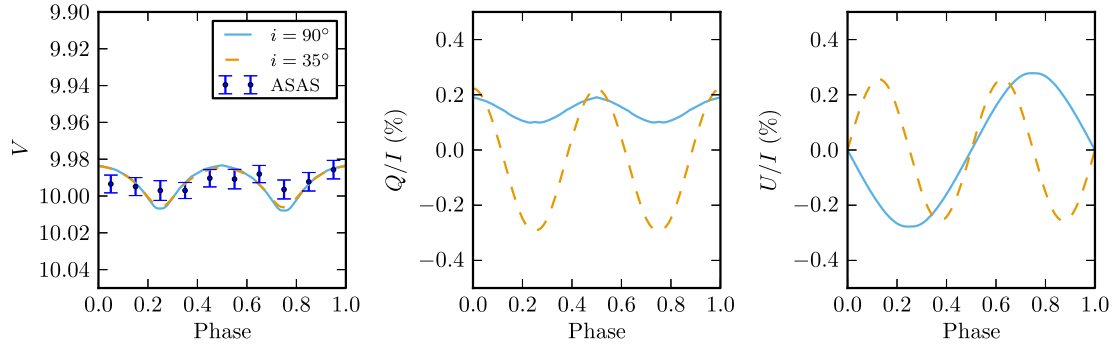
