I was there at 2:40 and could not  
find you, I <sup>also</sup> called at 8:00 in the evening.

The studies I have followed are - Piano,  
Voice, Harmony, Parlor Organ, and Public  
School methods, which I have specialized  
in. Then choir leading, orchestra playing,

sight singing and some band work as  
minor <sup>studies</sup>.

I was a member of the St. Thomas  
Choir, <sup>for a year</sup> where the masses are all from the best  
masters, and the words in Latin.

Sang in The Operas Patience, Carmen,  
 Gerontias and Fair Ellen, while at school.  
 There was a vacancy in the City system  
 in Ann Arbor in the Public School Method  
 and they gave me <sup>the</sup> first opportunity, but I was  
 too busy <sup>to accept</sup>.


and Mrs Susie Grant, Maud, = my wife,
