By letter of 25 February 1974 the President of the Council of the European Communities requested the European Parliament to deliver an opinion on the Communication from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council on the implementation of the 'Guidelines and priority measures for a Community energy policy'.

The President of the European Parliament referred this proposal to the Committee on Energy, Research and Technology, instructing it to consider the possibility of adopting the simplified procedure.

On 25 March 1974 the Committee on Energy, Research and Technology decided to apply the procedure for simplified consultation and the President was therefore instructed to submit the report to Parliament.

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the communication from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council (COM (74) 10 final),

1. Approves the Commission's Communication;
2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution and the report of its committee to the Council and Commission of the European Communities.
