The great Desire which Sir Tho: Adland has to see Bishop Chare makes him desirous of postponing his Journey from Tuesday to <sup>24</sup> Friday that he may meet Him here on Thursday but as it is a Matter of much Moment his putting off his Journey; How could not do it but with a Certainty of meeting Him: therefore if the Bishop puts off coming here to a more distant Day, Adland would wish to know it by a Line directed to Him at Warrens Hotel as early as you can let him know it to morrow & I should like to be informed of it also - Warrens Hotel is in Waterloo Place.
