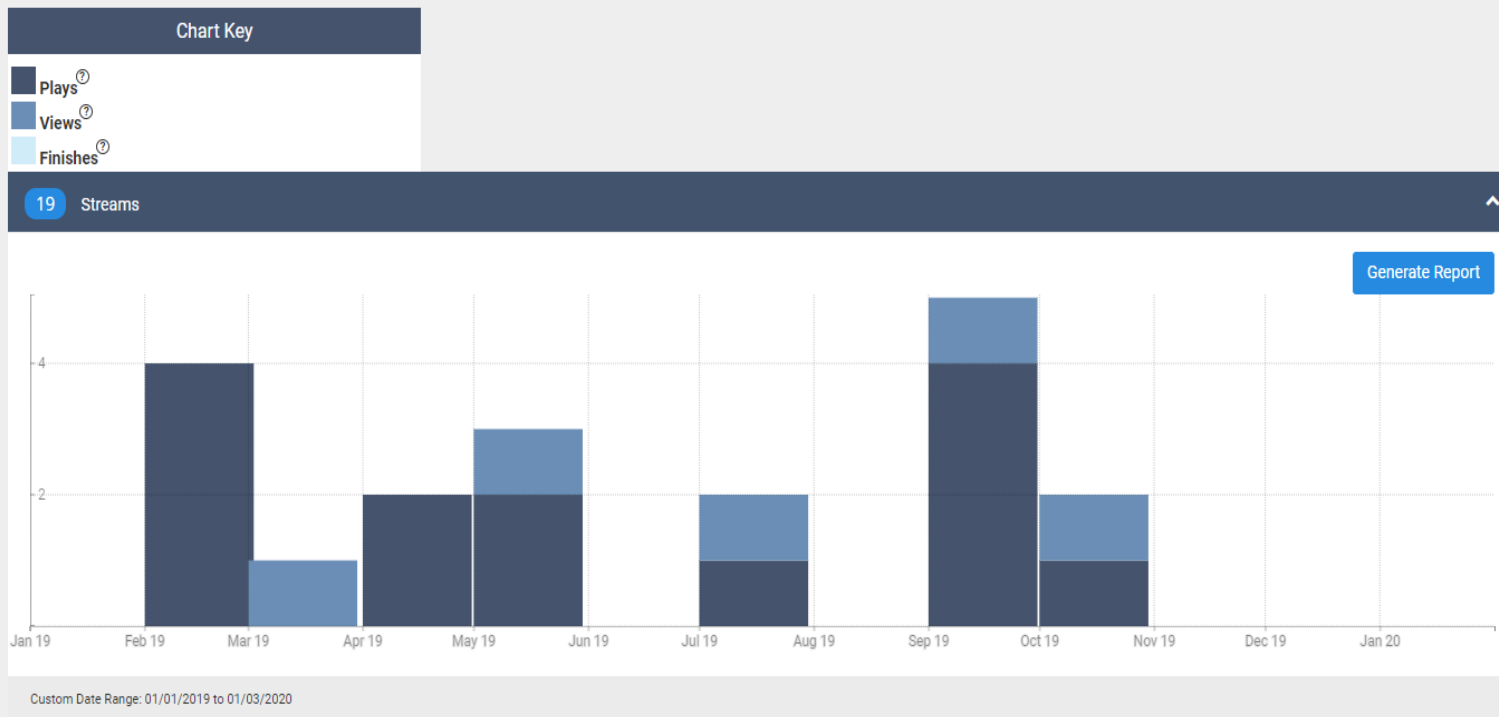

As emerging adults (18-29) transition to adulthood they will encounter various challenges related to their new adult roles (Arnett & Tanner, 2005; Jensen & Arnett, 2012). 

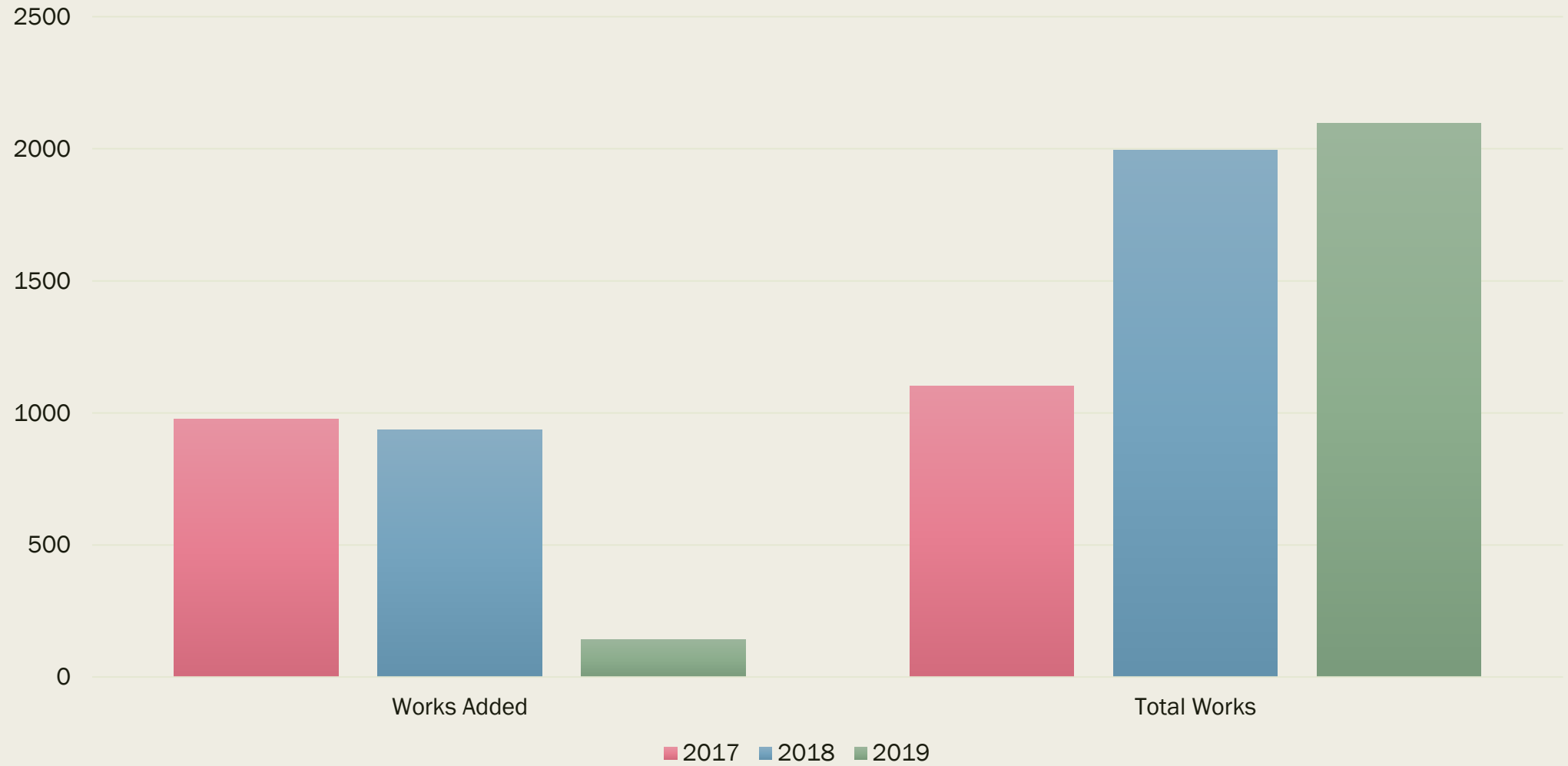
# Worldwide Readership 2019

## Readership Distribution

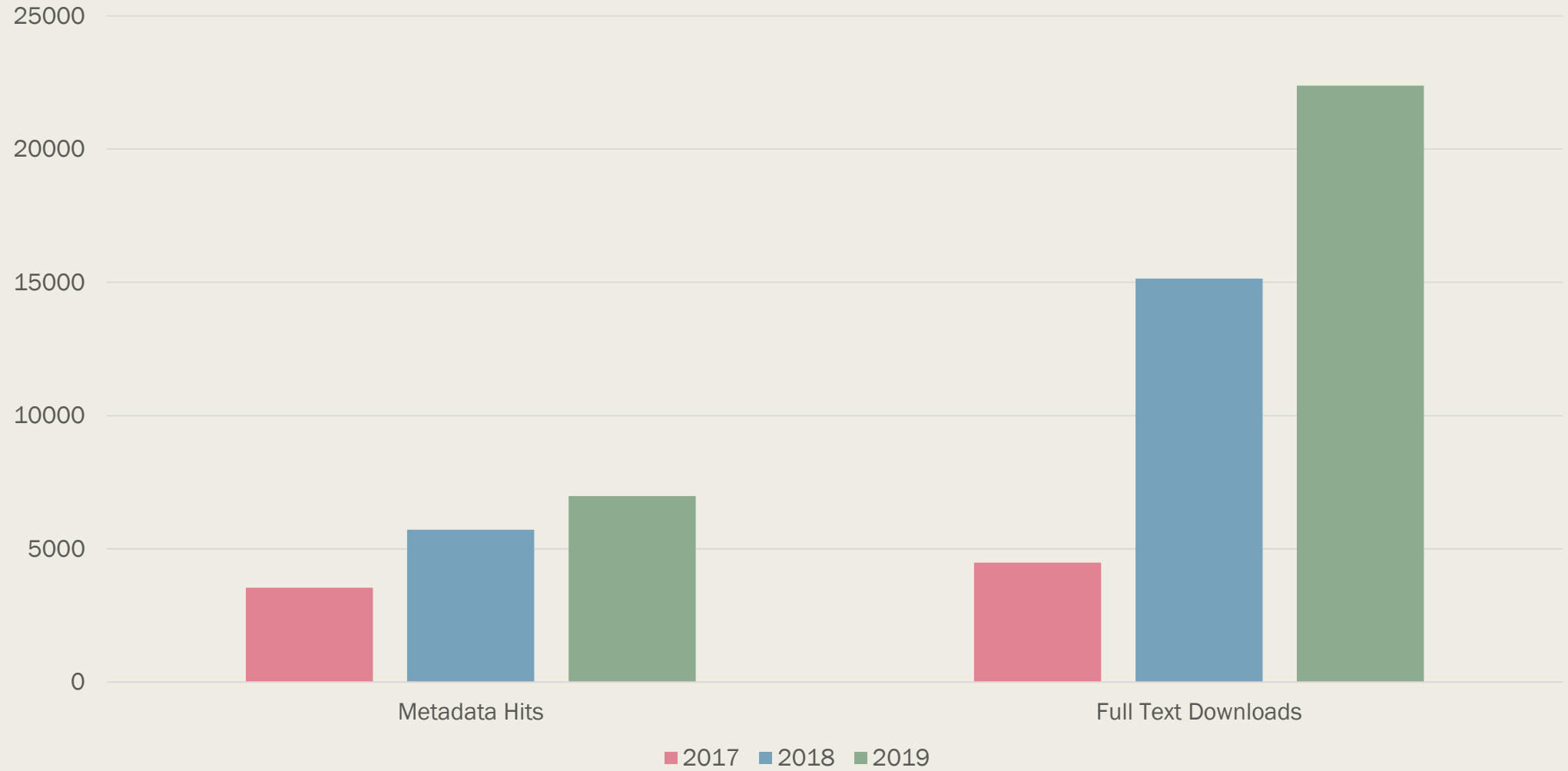

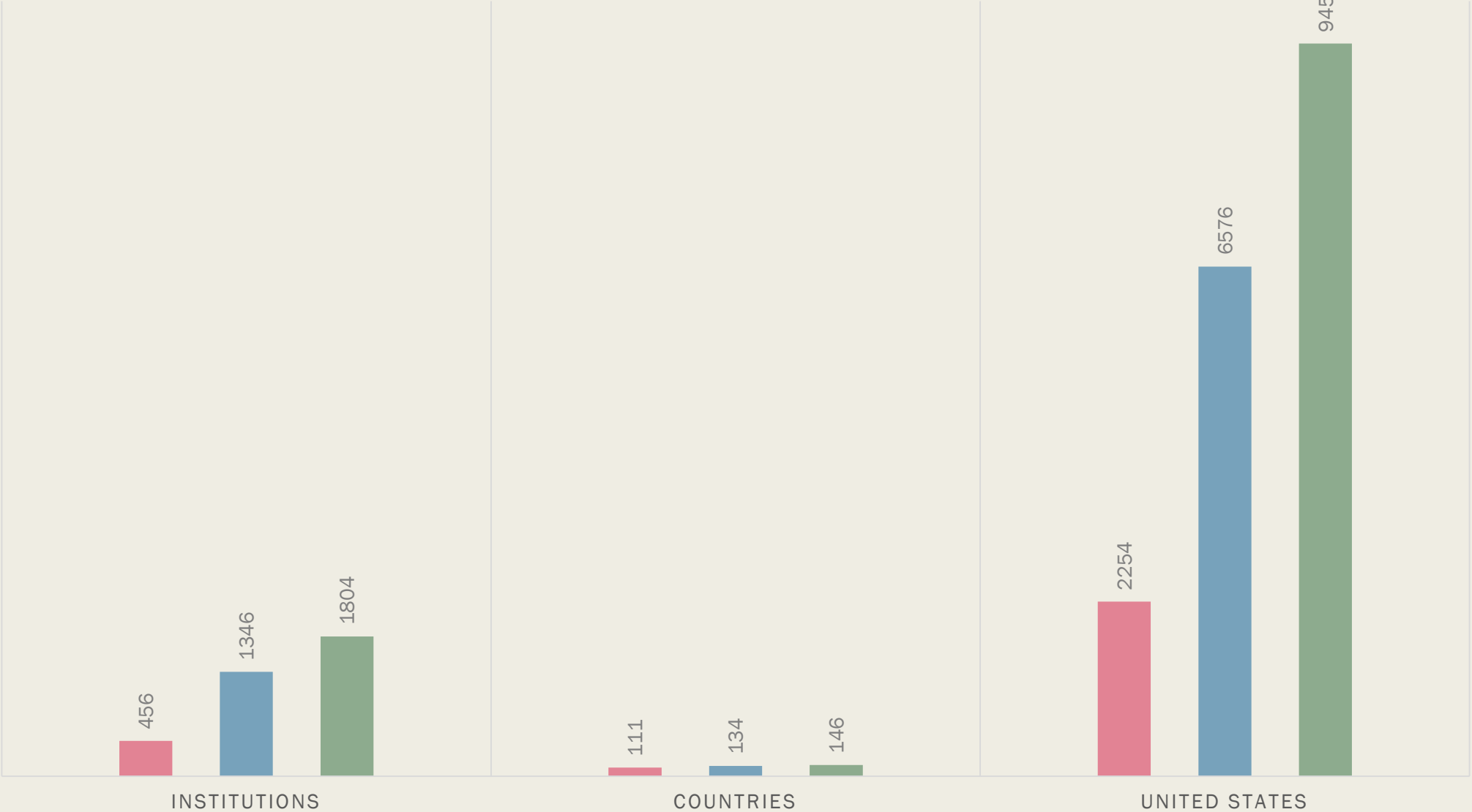

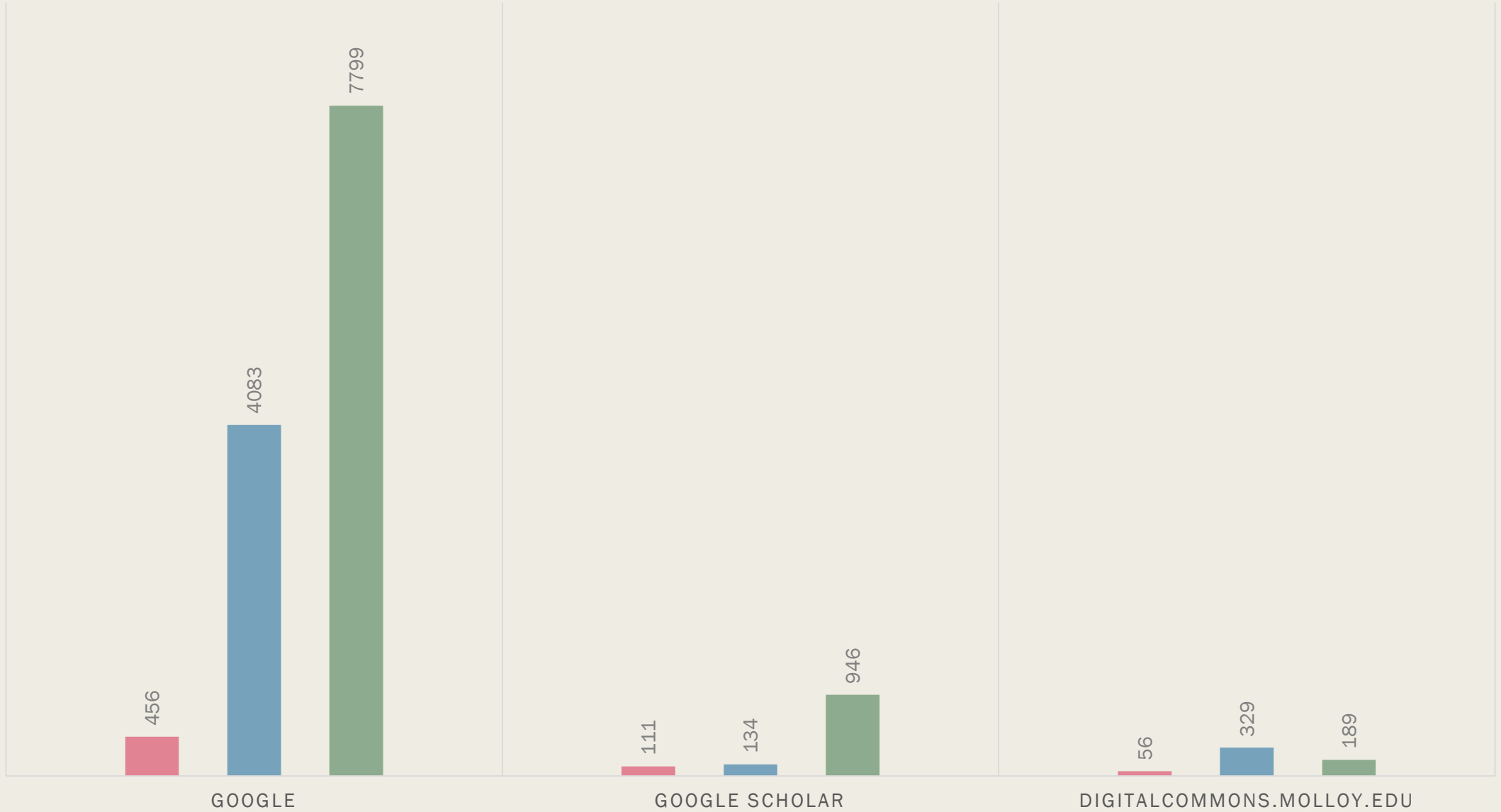

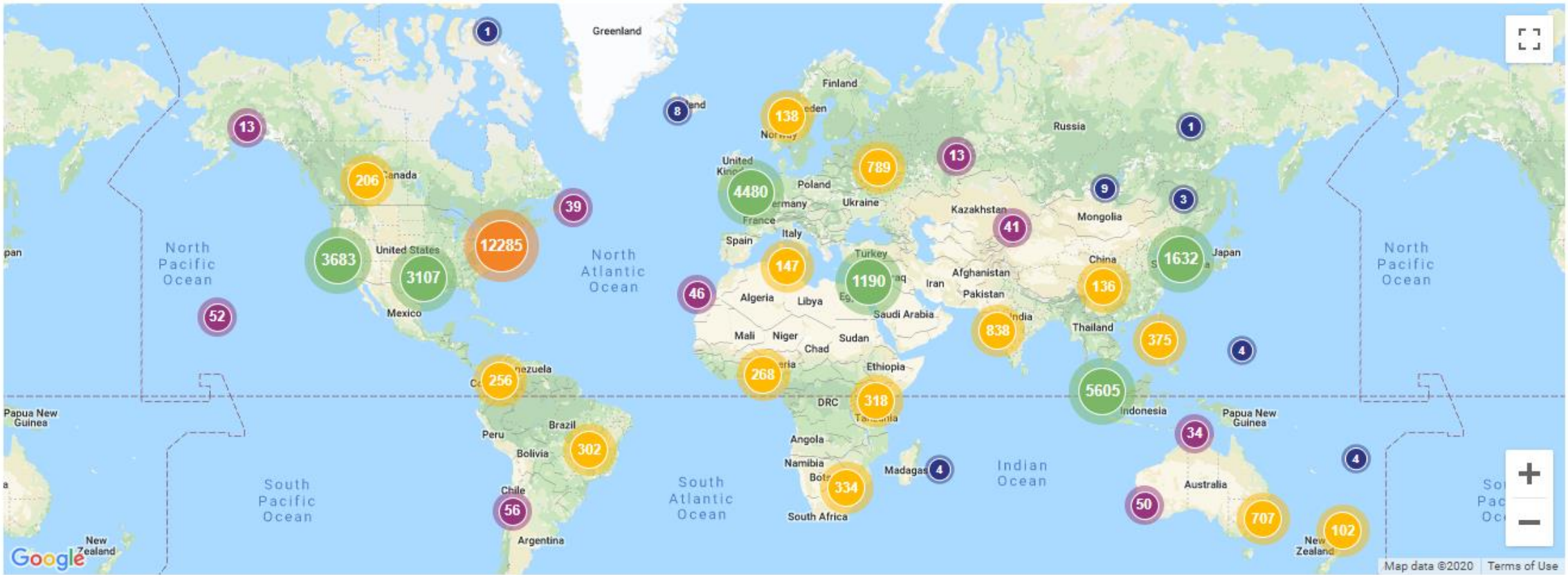
