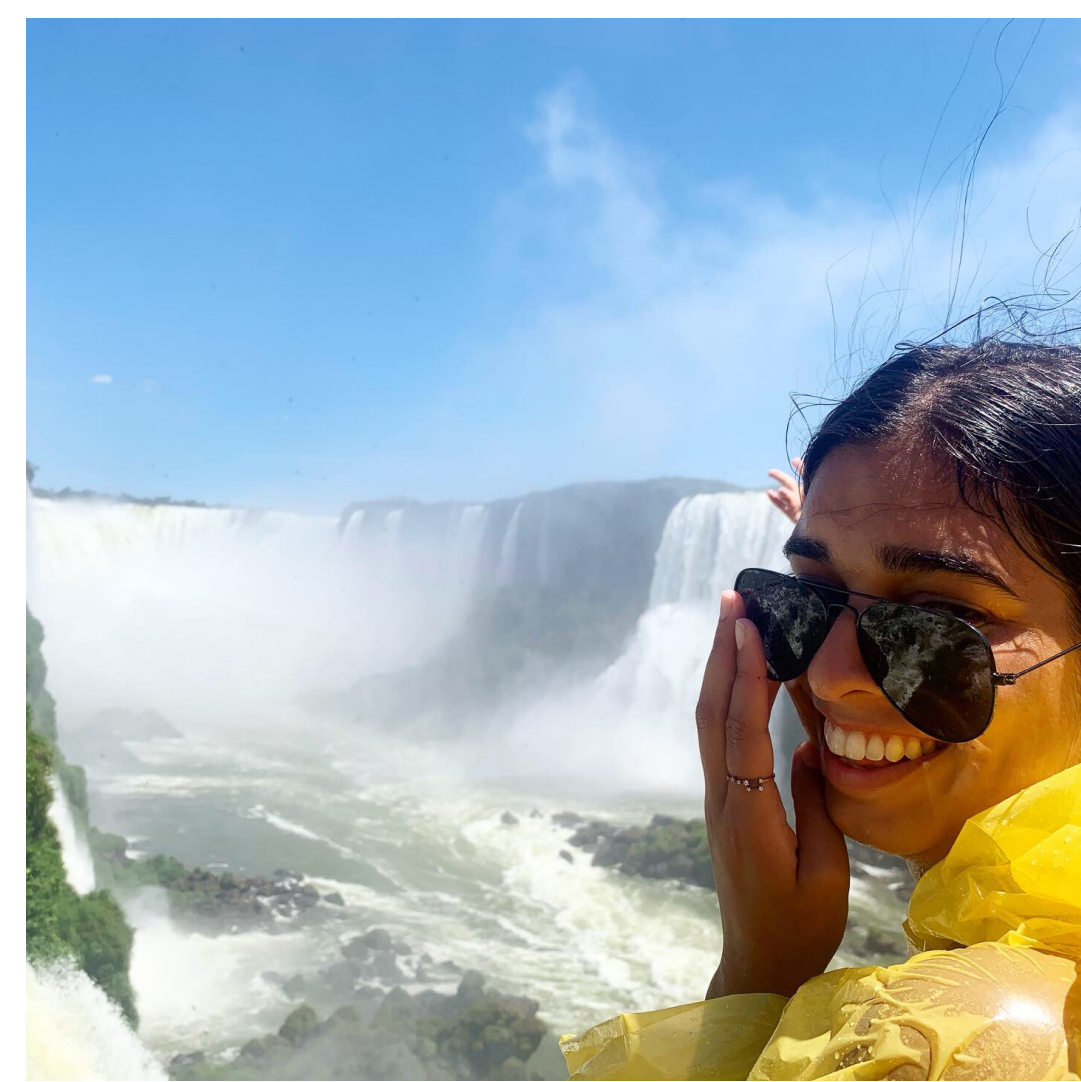
My STEP Project
