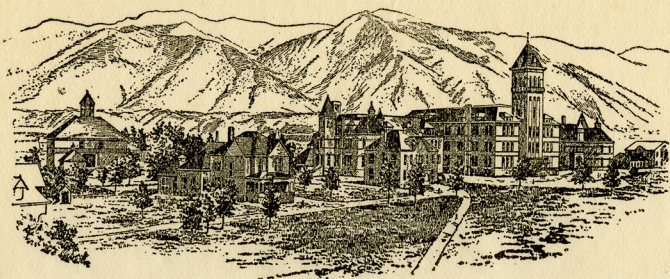

Logan, Utah, April 10, 1903.

At a meeting of the Commercial Club held on the above date, the following resolution was passed:

Resolved, That we, the members of the Commercial Club, do hereby agree to pay for half of the damage done in the Fray on Thursday, provided the Engineering Society will pay the other half. And be it further

Resolved, That a committee of three be appointed to confer with a like committee of the Engineers and with Supt. Batt, to make an invoice of the damage done and divide the expense equally between the two organizations.
