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

Registration for Continuing Education classes at Salve Regina College will be held in the Office of the Registrar, Ochre Court, September 16 - 20 from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. and from 7:00 - 9:00 p.m.

Credit courses are offered for renewal of teaching certificates, for strengthening background and for developing new interests. Preparation for teachers of the mentally retarded is offered through an organized continuing program of special education.

Courses will fulfill the needs of high school graduates and others who have completed some or all of their college credits. Advanced work in specialized areas for professional men and women is also provided.

Graduate Credit may be earned for particular courses so specified by making arrangements with the instructor to fulfill certain specified requirements at the time of course registration.

The following courses are offered:

MONDAY - Music in the Elementary School; Pottery and Stoneware;
Introduction to Data Processing; Spanish (Advanced Conversational and Composition); Psychology (Counseling Techniques); Introduction to Psychopharmacology.

TUESDAY - Speech in the Elementary School; Science for Secondary School Teachers; Structure of Poetry; French (Advanced Conversation and Composition); American Government.

Continuing Education at Salve (continued)

WEDNESDAY - Art History; Constitutional Law and Development; Tests and Measurements.

THURSDAY - French (Contemporary Novel in France); Social Studies (Africa - An Interdisciplinary Approach); Special Education (Of the Culturally Disadvantaged).

In addition the Psychology Department will offer two special courses which are part of a sequence which began during the 1968-69 academic year. They are: Social Psychology and a workshop in "Criminal Justice in Urban Society".

The Rhode Island Center for Police-Community Relations at Salve Regina will offer the following courses which are restricted to police officers only as a follow-up of courses in the 1969 summer session: Introduction to Community Sensitivity; Intermediate Community Sensitivity; Developmental Psychology; Adolescent Psychology.

The continuing education program is open to both men and women.

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
