Dear Dr. Silver:

Following his meeting with the Senate of the Faculty on October 9, 1963, Chancellor Williams asked me to write those members of the University faculty having tenure status a letter which might be retained in their personal files as a record of their having been granted tenure.

A provision of the tenure policy approved by the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning on November 19, 1962, states that "Adoption of the above regulations shall not affect the status of any faculty member now on continuous appointment."

Inasmuch as you had tenure status with the University of Mississippi prior to November 15, 1962, you are now considered by the University administration to have tenure under the provisions of the Board policy.
