Dear Jim:


I will be glad to get in touch with the appropriate consular officers and request that Mrs. Milburn's application for immigrant visa be handled with all possible speed.

I assume she is planning to bring her daughter, and it would help if you could let me have Mrs. Milburn's full name and the name and age of her daughter.

The collection of documents required, and the completion of security investigations, etc., are always time consuming, but I will certainly urge that there be no unnecessary delay. The British quota is current, so there is at least no waiting list problem involved.

If there is no information indicating otherwise when you send me the names, I will assume she is applying at the consulate at Belfast.
