MINUTES OF THE ALLOCATION COMMITTEE FOR THE STUDENT ACTIVITIES FUND SESSION OF 1952-53

The committee met in the Board Room on October 16, 1952. Those present were Deans Coulter; Hefley; Dunham; Guess, Chairman; Dr. David B. McCorkle, Director of Student Activities; Roy Pitts, President of the Associated Student Body.

The Chairman made a report to the Committee of the present status of the Social Affairs fund.

<sup>\* (</sup>This fund was authorized by the Allocations Committee on November 12, 1951, from unused funds allocated to the Social Affairs Committee in the session of 1951-52. The resolution setting up this fund provides that no part of it is to be spent by the Social Affairs Committee without the approval of the Allocations Committee.)

The Student Activity Fund for this session is approximately \$330 less than was allocated for the session of 1951-52. This made certain reductions necessary in the allocations.

Dean Dunham moved, Dean Coulter seconded, that in the future none of the funds from the Student Activity fee should be used for program or activities for the summer session. Motion carried by unanimous vote. (In the discussion, it was pointed out that there is a summer session recreation fee charged to summer session students.

It is the established policy of the Committee that the funds, as allocated, are for programs and other activities on the campus for University students. These funds are not to be used for expenses of programs given off the campus. Exception being traveling expenses for students sent to conferences for official training.

It is understood that the above named organizations are not to spend more than 50% of their allocation during the first semester.

The Chairman advised the Committee that the Student Social Affairs Committee will need to borrow \$875.00 to confirm the contract for Hal McIntyre's orchestra for a dance on November 15th. The Committee authorized the Chairman to request Mr. Carroll North, Comptroller, to write a letter of authorization to the local bank requesting that a loan be made to the A.S.B. Dance Committee for \$875.00. The Comptrollr will earmark the said amount of \$875.00 in the Student Activity Fund until such time as the A.S.B. Dance Committee pays this obligation.
