

You are notified that you have been reclassified this date in I-A.

Apparently you will be called for pre-induction physical examination sometime during the month of May, 1944. Probably May 8th, since that is the date of our next call for pre-induction.

In the event of your being found physically fit for service in the Armed Forces of the United States, the members of the Local Board will submit to State Selective Service Headquarters the request of Chancellor A. B. Butts for your deferment.

At the moment it is not permitted us to grant occupational status nor can we arrange for a postponement. This does not appear to be necessary as it is noted your work will not be interrupted for the remainder of the semester.

When you are ordered for pre-induction physical your medical examination records should have attached thereto statements from physicians to whom you have gone in connection with an allergy.

Kindly send such statements to the office at your earliest convenience.

Within the same 10-day period you may file a written request for personal appeatance before the local board. B If this is done, the time in which you may appeal is extended to 10 days from the date of mailing of a new Notice of Classification (Form 57) after such personal appearance,
