Dear Jim:


Forgive my delay in answering your recent letter. As you can imagine, things have been busy here.

I hope you will continue to keep me in touch with the situation in Oxford.

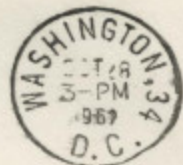
