was over this after noon

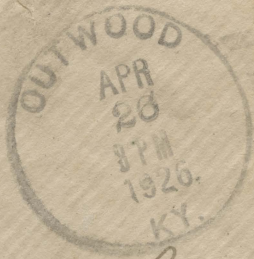
