You can get whatever course you desire and this University works closely with the Louisiana State University and much colaoration in work and study is done by the two Universities working to gether and there are no better Libraries at any University in America than is at Southern.

Further Southern University is the Largest All Negro University in the Worls. It is larger that University of Miss. and they have just as good faculty, many white professors and many white technicians and teir President Dr. Clark ranks along with the best in Americ. My advice to you is come to Southern University at Sociandville, a suburb of Baton Rouge and you will there be welcome and in an environment that you will delight in and can pursue whatever course you so desire. Then further all of this stir will end you will thank me 4 years from now for giving you this advise. That will suit everybody and if we have to fight Russia and Cuba we can all pull together, which could happen.
