I am fifteen years old.

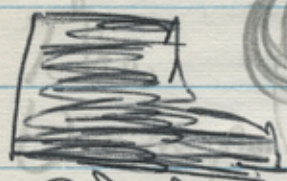

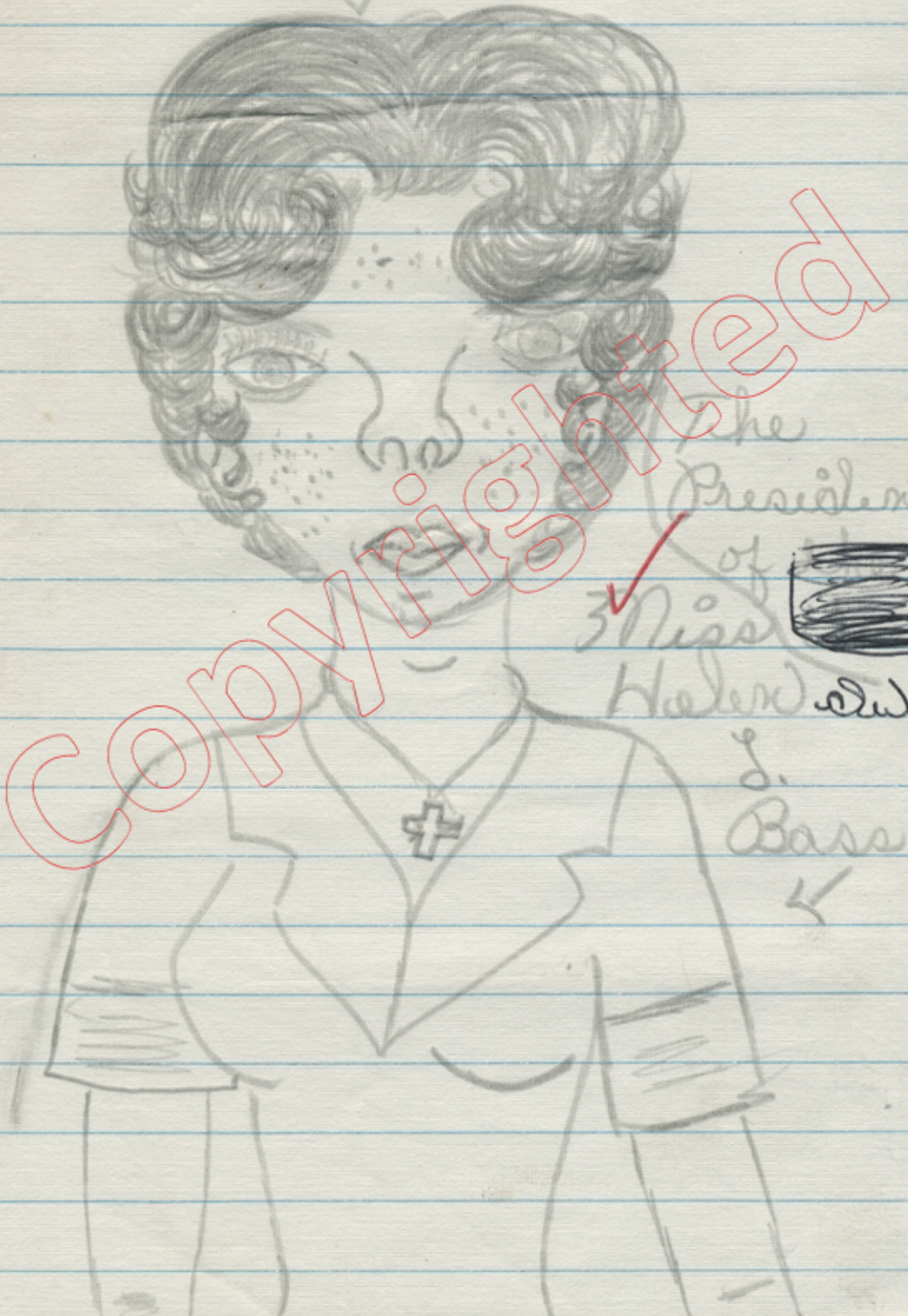
