
Dear Senator Eastland:

Your view about the importance of the Congressional role under the 25th amendment is one that I fully share, for I feel that under this amendment Congress is acting on behalf of the American electorate.

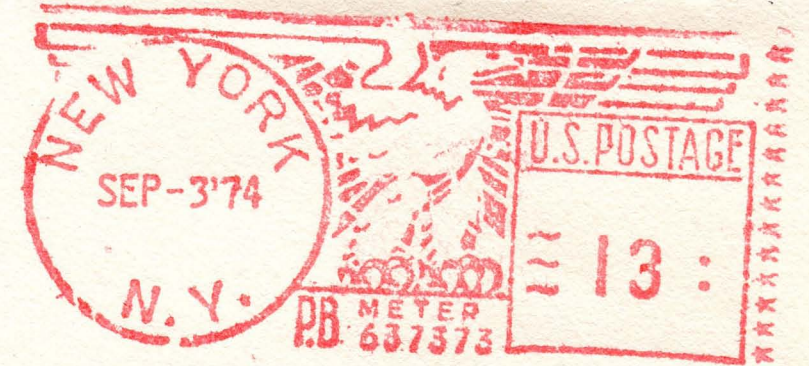
